Supplement Title: Initial

On 02/23/2026 at approximately 1620 HRS, I was dispatched to the lobby to speak with a Child Protection Specialist from the Cuyahoga County Division of Children and Family Services about suspected child abuse.

I spoke with Child Protection Specialist, [REDACTED], about a series of events involving, [REDACTED] (2 YOA), father [REDACTED], and mother [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated last week [REDACTED] was taken to Cleveland Clinic Main Campus and was diagnosed with a mid-right clavicle fracture. [REDACTED] was assessed by the Child Protection Team to include [REDACTED] whom stated while this injury is common among children, but there is a bruise that accompanies the injury that appears to be in a handprint and appears to have been inflicted. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was with [REDACTED], whom resides at [REDACTED], at the time the injury was sustained. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are divorced so once [REDACTED] had [REDACTED] back in her care, she observed the injury and sought medical care.

[REDACTED] stated she initiated her case on Friday (2/20/26), [REDACTED] disclosed there was also a Domestic Violence incident that occurred around the end of January (2026) or early this month. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] stated she had a picture taken 02/01/2026, from when she went to pick up [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] home and [REDACTED] grabbed [REDACTED] and threw her against the wall, which resulted in an obvious grab mark on her upper arm and bruising to her stomach and side where she hit the wall. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] also said this incident occurred in front of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] further disclosed another Domestic Violence incident that occurred when she went to pick up [REDACTED] in March of 2025, and also stated [REDACTED] has previously held a gun to her head as well.

I spoke further with [REDACTED] about the timeline of the above events and [REDACTED] stated this actually began the weekend of 2/14-15/2026.

[REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] had [REDACTED] in his custody over the aforementioned weekend, and per their custody agreement, [REDACTED] has [REDACTED] normally Thursdays-Sundays and each parent gets FaceTime with [REDACTED] at 0900am when [REDACTED] is with the other parent. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] stated she saw [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] on 2/14/26 at a dance group for [REDACTED] that they both attended. On 2/15/25, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] FaceTimed [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] was inconsolable and [REDACTED] stated it was the worst night he has ever had with her, [REDACTED] had an anxiety attack. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] stated she offered to come over to [REDACTED] house, which she did, was able to calm [REDACTED] down and left. Later, [REDACTED] stated while [REDACTED] was with [REDACTED], [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] said "Daddy kill you."

On 2/16/26, when [REDACTED] got to [REDACTED] residence, a doctor came directly to her residence to see [REDACTED] and did a strep test, to which [REDACTED] was diagnosed with strep. [REDACTED] noted later, there were no injuries reported by the doctor on Monday but [REDACTED] reported noticing [REDACTED] was favoring her right side (injured side). [REDACTED] also later advised, [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] said "Daddy kill you", at which time [REDACTED] emailed [REDACTED] due to this being concerning to ask him about it. [REDACTED] stated

████ said in the email █████ did say that but denied █████ would have heard anything like that from him.

████ then went back to █████ residence on 2/17/26 at 1700 HRS and then back to █████ residence on 2/18/26 by way of █████ Nanny at 0900 HRS. █████ stated █████ gave █████ a bath around 1500 HRS, and this was the first time she had seen █████ fully undressed and observed the bruising in the injured area. █████ stated █████ followed up with █████ Primary Care Physician (PCP) whom told █████ to have █████ seen. █████ stated █████ took █████ to the Urgent Care and █████ had an inconclusive x-ray done, at which time the PCP advised █████ to take █████ to Cleveland Clinic Main Campus on 2/19/26.

████ stated █████ was then diagnosed with the fracture and what appeared to be a hand print bruise. █████ stated █████ took pictures of █████ injury on 2/18/26 and █████ also took pictures during her visit with █████ and █████ on 2/20/26. I was able to review the photos which will be sent over with DCFS's full investigative report. In the pictures I observed █████ to have bruising in her right upper clavicle and shoulder area. █████ stated in regards to the pictures, █████ determined the injury appeared consistent with someone sitting behind the child, grabbing the child's right shoulder, with their left hand, because there appears to be a thumbprint mark on the back of her shoulder. █████ stated at this time, █████ reached out to DCFS at which time, █████ initiated her case.

████ has been in █████ custody since and is scheduled to return to █████ on 2/26/26. █████ stated she interviewed █████ on 2/20/26 at 1530 HRS and has not yet talked to █████. █████ stated she does not believe █████ is aware she will be reaching out but plans to try and reach him tomorrow 2/24/26.

████ stated she will be sending her DCFS case file with the pictures to my email. At the time this report was completed I have not received the report.

████ and I spoke about follow up. █████ and I spoke about the aforementioned alleged Domestic Violence incidents, a previous BVPD incident (ref 25-00944) and an incident █████ stated occurred in Rocky River in 2024 in which █████ threw hot water on █████ and █████ sustained injuries. To be noted █████ stated she saw the photograph of the bruising █████ reported from the incident on 2/1/26 but █████ would not give it to her. █████ stated █████ didn't really want to share after she found out █████ would have to make a report.

████ and I concluded our interview talking about █████ medical records. █████ stated █████ signed off on the release of █████ medical records. █████ also stated the Child Protection Social Worker would also be able to release █████ assessment. Lastly, █████ stated due to the nature of this assessment that was obtained by DCFS late on 2/20/26, she was mandatory reporting to law enforcement today. I asked █████ if she thought █████ was planning on coming to BVPD and she stated she did not believe so.

Det. Sgt. Chapman was advised of the incident immediately following my interview with █████.

On 02.24.2026, at 0840 HRS., I contacted [REDACTED] via telephone and left a voicemail requesting a call back. Shortly thereafter, [REDACTED] contacted me back by telephone. I advised [REDACTED] my call was regarding information provided to the Bay Village Police Department by Children and Family Services involving an injury to her 2-year-old daughter, [REDACTED]. I asked [REDACTED] if she was available for an in-person interview today concerning [REDACTED] injury. [REDACTED] stated she was currently in [REDACTED] visiting her mother and arrived there on Saturday, 02/21/2026. [REDACTED] reported she intended to return to Ohio on Thursday, 02/26/2026, as that was the date [REDACTED] father, [REDACTED], was scheduled to resume his parenting time in accordance with the existing child custody agreement. [REDACTED] further stated that if the custody order changed due to the ongoing investigation, she did not plan to return to Ohio until Sunday, 03/01/2026. [REDACTED] inquired if the interview could be conducted over the phone. I advised [REDACTED] the BVPD did not conduct phone interviews for matters of this nature. I informed [REDACTED] that I would contact her back shortly, with the appropriate course of action.

At 0940 HRS., I spoke to [REDACTED] via telephone and informed her that the interview regarding [REDACTED] injury must be conducted in person in a video and audio-recorded setting. I also advised [REDACTED] that I would need to see [REDACTED] in person. I asked [REDACTED] if she could make arrangements to return to Ohio as soon as possible. [REDACTED] stated she would arrange to come home. [REDACTED] then advised that [REDACTED] was "blowing up" her phone and asked whether she was required to answer his calls or emails. Before I could respond, [REDACTED] stated she had an incoming call from the [REDACTED] Police Department. [REDACTED] became emotional and began crying, stating that [REDACTED] was going to request [REDACTED] Police to conduct a welfare check on [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she would call me back.

At 1017 HRS., I reached out to [REDACTED] again via telephone. I again advised [REDACTED] that the interview regarding [REDACTED] injury must be conducted in person. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] bruising was "all but healed." [REDACTED] further reported that the next step in [REDACTED] healing process was to obtain an additional X-ray on Thursday, 02/26/2026, and that [REDACTED] also had an appointment scheduled with Cleveland Clinic Orthopedics on the same date. [REDACTED] stated she would book a flight back to Cleveland on Wednesday, 02/25/2026, and planned to come to the Bay Village Police Department between 1600–1700 hours on 02/25/2026 for the interview. I advised [REDACTED] that after completing her interview, I would need to visually assess [REDACTED] and take photographs for documentation.

I asked [REDACTED] to provide a general timeline of when she first noticed something was wrong with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] explained that, per the child custody agreement, [REDACTED] regular parenting time is from Thursday at 1800 hours through Sunday at 1800 hours every other weekend. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] travels frequently for work and is home one week per month. During the week he is home, an additional 48-hour extension is added to either the beginning or end of his scheduled weekend.

[REDACTED] reported that, due to this travel schedule, [REDACTED] had parenting time with [REDACTED] beginning Thursday, February 12th, 2026, through Tuesday, February 24th, 2026. [REDACTED] stated that whichever parent is not in possession of [REDACTED] is responsible for picking her up at the end of the other parent's visitation period. [REDACTED] further explained that, according to the custody agreement, she had holiday parenting time on Presidents' Day, Monday, February 16th, 2026, from 0800–2000 hours. [REDACTED] stated that because [REDACTED] was not feeling well, [REDACTED] stayed overnight at [REDACTED] residence rather than returning to [REDACTED] home that evening. I asked [REDACTED] what she meant when she stated that [REDACTED]

was not feeling well. [REDACTED] said she would “back up” and begin with Saturday, February 14th, 2026.

[REDACTED] stated that she saw [REDACTED] on Saturday, February 14th, 2026, during [REDACTED] class at the [REDACTED] Recreation Center. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were both present for the class. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] left early and requested that [REDACTED] be returned to him at 1300 hours. [REDACTED] stated she took [REDACTED] back to her own residence to play because it was close to [REDACTED] nap time. [REDACTED] said she asked [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] could remain at her home for the nap, but acknowledged she only provided him approximately 20 minutes notice. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] became upset, and [REDACTED] admitted it was her fault for not giving [REDACTED] adequate notice. [REDACTED] said she then drove [REDACTED] back to [REDACTED] residence and arrived approximately 20 minutes late.

On Sunday, February 15, 2026, [REDACTED] stated she attempted to FaceTime [REDACTED] at approximately 0900 hours. [REDACTED] explained that, per the custody agreement, each parent is permitted to FaceTime [REDACTED] between 0900 and 0915 hours using the “Our Family Wizard” application. When [REDACTED] did not answer, [REDACTED] messaged [REDACTED] through the application to ask when she could FaceTime. A short time later, [REDACTED] called [REDACTED] via FaceTime. [REDACTED] stated she observed [REDACTED] lying in [REDACTED] bed and not moving much. [REDACTED] audibly groaned, to mimic the noises [REDACTED] was making. [REDACTED] attempted to engage [REDACTED] by being playful, but [REDACTED] continued acting unusually and was not taking off her sleep sack, which [REDACTED] stated is typically [REDACTED] favorite thing to do in the morning. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] acknowledged [REDACTED] was acting unusual. [REDACTED] reported she offered to assist [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] ultimately agreed to allow [REDACTED] to come over. [REDACTED] estimated she arrived at [REDACTED] residence shortly after 1000 hours.

[REDACTED] stated that when she arrived at [REDACTED] residence, she observed [REDACTED] crying on the couch in a fetal position. [REDACTED] then clung to [REDACTED] body like a frog. [REDACTED] reported that her goal at that time was to try to get [REDACTED] to eat something and help her feel better. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] typically visits his parents in [REDACTED] every Sunday and had planned to take [REDACTED] with him; however, due to [REDACTED] unusual behavior, [REDACTED] chose not to go to his parents. [REDACTED] reported she sat with [REDACTED] at a small table and asked [REDACTED] what was wrong. According to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] responded by stating, “Daddy kill you.” [REDACTED] stated she looked at [REDACTED] after hearing this, and [REDACTED] replied, “I swear I don’t know where she learned that.”

I advised [REDACTED] I wanted to hear about all these specific details, however, I requested we discuss details in person. I explained to [REDACTED] I only wished to discuss a timeline of dates of who was with [REDACTED] on what days. [REDACTED] stated she picked [REDACTED] up from [REDACTED] house at 0800 on Monday February 16th. [REDACTED] was still acting strange, so [REDACTED] contacted Pediatrician [REDACTED] from [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] made a home visit to [REDACTED] house on Monday February 16th to assess [REDACTED] and a Strep test was performed, which [REDACTED] tested positive for. [REDACTED] spent the night at [REDACTED] house Monday night, due to [REDACTED] being sick. [REDACTED] seemingly appeared in better health Tuesday February 17th. [REDACTED] returned to [REDACTED] house on Tuesday February 17th, where she remained overnight.

[REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] returned to [REDACTED] house on the morning of Wednesday February 18th. At 1630 HRS., while giving [REDACTED] a bath, [REDACTED] noticed a large yellowing bruise on [REDACTED] neck. [REDACTED] sent a picture of the bruise to the nanny, [REDACTED], who had no knowledge of how [REDACTED] obtained the bruise. [REDACTED] stated she sent a picture of the bruise to her pediatrician ([REDACTED]), who believed [REDACTED] should be seen by a medical provider. At approximately 1730 HRS., [REDACTED] took [REDACTED] to the Cleveland Clinic Fairview Emergency Department. [REDACTED] notified [REDACTED] of her intention to have [REDACTED] seen at the emergency room, due to the injury. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] arrived at the emergency room approximately two hours after [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] arrived. [REDACTED] stated the wait was long and [REDACTED] didn’t want to be there. [REDACTED] messaged her doctor and asked if it was ok if they left the emergency

room. [REDACTED] indicated they could leave the emergency room , only if [REDACTED] was seen the following day. On Thursday February 19th, 2026, [REDACTED] had an xray completed at Cleveland Clinic Main Campus that verified her collar bone was broken.

I asked [REDACTED] if she had a suspicion of who caused the injury to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] paused for a moment, clearly becoming emotional, before saying, "I don't know". I asked [REDACTED] if she had any belief that [REDACTED] inflicted the injury to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated, "yeah".

[REDACTED] inquired if she was in trouble for not taking [REDACTED] to the doctor sooner. I advised [REDACTED] we would be conducting an impartial investigation, gathering all the facts necessary to determine the next course of action.

[REDACTED] inquired if she had to answer [REDACTED] phone calls. I advised [REDACTED] to follow her attorney's advice per her custody arrangements.

At approximately 1713 HRS., [REDACTED] emailed me the following medical documents relevant to [REDACTED] injury: Cleveland Clinic ED After Visit Summary, Cleveland Clinic Main Campus ED Provider Notes and [REDACTED] Report. The aforementioned documents were added to this investigation's case file.

On 02.25.2026, at approximately 1624 HRS., Det. Sgt Chapman and I met [REDACTED] at her residential home for an interview. Upon arrival, I was met at the front door by [REDACTED], who was accompanied by her attorney, Donovan DeLuca. Det. Sgt. Chapman and I were escorted into the dining room area. I advised [REDACTED] the purpose of this visit was to follow up on the report filed by Children Family Services regarding the injury to her daughter, [REDACTED]. I first asked [REDACTED] to begin by explaining the status of her divorce and the current child-custody plan in place for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she moved out of her joint residence with [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] in August of 2024. The current child custody agreement provides [REDACTED] parenting time with [REDACTED] every Thursday at 6:00 PM through Sunday at 6:00 PM. According to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] travels frequently for work and is home approximately one week per month for "district week". [REDACTED] stated during the weeks [REDACTED] is home, an additional 48 hours are added to his parenting time, applied either to the beginning or the end of the designated weekend period.

[REDACTED] stated that each parent has designated holidays outlined in the current custody order. She reported that President's Day, February 16th, from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM, was assigned to [REDACTED] for parenting time. However, [REDACTED] stated that she and [REDACTED] have a mutual understanding that drop-off occurs at 7:00 PM due to their child's bedtime. [REDACTED] further stated that, per their agreement, the parent who does not have [REDACTED] is responsible for conducting the pick-up.

On Thursday, February 12th, 2026, at approximately 1800 hours, [REDACTED] picked up [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] residence for his scheduled weekend parenting time. [REDACTED] had no further contact with [REDACTED] following the pickup. [REDACTED] stated that the next communication regarding [REDACTED] occurred on Friday, February 13th, 2026, at approximately 0900 hours during a scheduled daily FaceTime call. [REDACTED] explained that each parent is permitted to FaceTime [REDACTED] at 0900 hours every day. [REDACTED] further stated that [REDACTED] prefers she conduct the FaceTime calls through the nanny, identified as [REDACTED], rather than directly with him.

On Saturday, February 14th, 2026, [REDACTED] was scheduled to attend a dance/ballet class called [REDACTED] at the [REDACTED] Recreation Center. [REDACTED] reported that both she and [REDACTED] regularly attend this class with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] left the class early due to other obligations. After class, [REDACTED] took [REDACTED] to her home, where she cared for her for several hours. [REDACTED] stated that she and [REDACTED] played in the playroom and later ate lunch at her residence. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] agreed that [REDACTED] would return [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] residence at approximately 1300 hours. [REDACTED] further stated that she requested permission for [REDACTED] to take her nap at [REDACTED] home due to [REDACTED] appearing tired, but it was agreed that [REDACTED] would return to [REDACTED] house around 1300 hours and nap there.

On Sunday, February 15th, 2026, at approximately 0900 hours, [REDACTED] attempted to conduct her scheduled FaceTime call with [REDACTED] through the communication platform Our Family Wizard. [REDACTED] reported that the call went unanswered. [REDACTED] stated the call was returned approximately between 0930 and 0940 hours, later than the agreed-upon time. During the returned video call, [REDACTED] observed [REDACTED] lying down in a sleep sack on [REDACTED] bed. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] appeared upset. [REDACTED] reported that she initially assumed [REDACTED] had experienced a rough night, which she explained occasionally happens. [REDACTED] attempted to interact with [REDACTED] through the video call; however, [REDACTED] continued lying down, crying, and did not engage with the usual playful movements [REDACTED] uses during their calls.

█████ stated she asked █████ if she could bring breakfast for █████, and █████ ultimately agreed. █████ arrived at █████ residence at approximately 1000–1015 hours. Upon arrival, █████ observed █████ on the couch crying, still in her sleep sack and pajamas. █████ stated that only █████, █████, and their two dogs were present inside the residence at that time. █████ reported that █████ wrapped her arms and legs around █████ body, which █████ described as acting like a “leap frog.” █████ stated she rocked and played with █████ for approximately 20 minutes. █████ had brought several of █████ preferred toys inside a backpack. █████ removed █████ sleep sack and attempted to get her to eat. █████ described a small toddler table and chair located in the living room where █████ typically eats at █████ residence. █████ stated she offered █████ her favorite yogurt with dried strawberries, along with additional food items available in the home such as eggs and sausage, but █████ refused all food.

█████ eventually engaged █████ in play using a book titled Larry the Monster. █████ then began to play with some of her food utensils. While interacting, █████ asked █████ what was wrong. █████ reported that █████ responded by saying, “Daddy kill you. Daddy kill you.” █████ stated that both she and █████ looked at one another after █████ made the statement. █████ reported that █████ responded by saying, “I don’t know where she heard that. I swear I don’t know where she heard that.”

█████ stated that █████ informed her he had cancelled his plans to visit his parents on Sunday February 15th, due to █████ being sick. █████ estimated she remained at █████ residence for approximately 1 to 1.5 hours in total before leaving. █████ reported that █████ attempted to warm up pasta for █████ to eat for lunch, but █████ did not want to eat it. █████ stated she left █████ residence prior to █████ nap time. █████ advised she followed up with █████ after █████ nap, and █████ told her that █████ took a good nap and that everything was okay.

I asked █████ if she observed any injuries on █████ body or if █████ appeared to favor any part of her body on either Saturday February 14th or Sunday February 15th. █████ stated she did not notice anything unusual or concerning about █████ on Saturday, February 14th, 2026. Regarding Sunday, February 15th, 2026, █████ stated she could not say whether █████ was favoring any specific part of her body because █████ was lethargic and not using her body in a typical manner. I asked █████ if she had changed █████ clothing at any point on Sunday. █████ stated she only removed █████ sleep sack, but did not change her clothes. I then asked █████ whether she had to physically lift █████ to place her in a high chair to eat on Sunday. █████ stated no, explaining that █████ ate at a small toddler table located in █████ living room, and █████ is able to sit at that table without any assistance.

On Monday, February 18th, 2026, █████ picked up █████ from █████ residence at approximately 0800 hours. █████ stated she believes she went inside the residence briefly because █████ was still getting ready. █████ reported that █████ told her █████ had a rough night of sleep. █████ stated █████ continued to act unusual and was behaving similarly to how she had behaved on Sunday. █████ stated that █████ nanny, identified as █████, arrived at █████ residence at approximately 0900 hours. █████ advised that █████ work schedule is Monday through Friday from 0900 to 1500 hours, and █████ goes to whichever house █████ is staying at. █████ stated that █████ also observed that █████ was not acting like herself. █████ stated she assumed █████ had not slept well. █████ explained that she and █████ differ in their approaches to nap and bedtime routines. According to █████, she maintains a strict schedule for █████ sleep, whereas █████ may suggest skipping nap times or putting █████ to bed later to encourage her to sleep in the next morning. Due to █████ continuing to present as unusual, █████ stated she contacted █████ with █████.

█████ stated that █████ arrived at her residence for a home visit on Monday, sometime

before noon. According to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] performed a Strep test on [REDACTED] which showed a faint positive line. [REDACTED] subsequently prescribed Amoxicillin for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she notified [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] had tested positive for Strep, and both she and [REDACTED] agreed that [REDACTED] would spend the night at [REDACTED] residence due to her illness. I asked [REDACTED] to describe what else she did with [REDACTED] that day. [REDACTED] requested to look at photographs on her phone to assist with recalling the events. [REDACTED] showed Sgt. Chapman and I a photograph of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] laying on the couch. [REDACTED] stated she remembered that [REDACTED] wanted to be held frequently while she was sick with Strep. [REDACTED] explained that because [REDACTED] wanted to be held so often, she used a baby carrier to carry [REDACTED], noting that she had not used the carrier since [REDACTED] was younger.

[REDACTED] stated that on Tuesday, [REDACTED] appeared to be improving after receiving two doses of antibiotics. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] agreed that [REDACTED] would spend Tuesday night at [REDACTED] residence, as [REDACTED] had not had his scheduled overnight with [REDACTED] the previous night due to her illness. According to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] picked [REDACTED] up from her residence at approximately 1700 hours. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] woke from her nap at approximately 1530 hours, and they remained at [REDACTED] residence until [REDACTED] arrived. [REDACTED] reported that she works from home and that the nanny, identified as [REDACTED], assists with caring for [REDACTED] between 0900 and 1500 hours each weekday. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] typically goes down for a nap at 1300 hours and wakes around 1530 hours. [REDACTED] stated that when [REDACTED] woke from her nap on Tuesday, she again appeared sick, clingy, and irritable. [REDACTED] informed [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] was acting fussy again after waking up from her nap. When asked, [REDACTED] stated that while in [REDACTED] care, [REDACTED] naps in her upstairs bedroom in a crib.

On Wednesday, February 18, 2026, at approximately 0900 hours, [REDACTED] picked up [REDACTED] and the dogs from [REDACTED] residence and transported them to [REDACTED] home. At around 1000 hours, [REDACTED] took [REDACTED] to the library while [REDACTED] was working from home. Upon returning from the library, [REDACTED] said goodnight to [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] home office before being put down for a nap. [REDACTED] awoke from her nap at approximately 1530 hours, at which time [REDACTED] got [REDACTED] out of her crib. [REDACTED] did not notice any behavior change when getting [REDACTED] out of her crib. Due to inclement weather, [REDACTED] elected to allow [REDACTED] to play in the bathtub at approximately 1630 hours. While preparing [REDACTED] for the bath, [REDACTED] observed a large yellowing bruise on [REDACTED] shoulder area. [REDACTED] contacted the nanny, [REDACTED], to ask whether she had noticed the bruise; [REDACTED] reported she had not. [REDACTED] then sent a text message to [REDACTED] regarding the injury. [REDACTED] asked whether [REDACTED] appeared to be in pain. [REDACTED] recorded a video of herself touching [REDACTED] right collarbone, which caused [REDACTED] to cry in pain. [REDACTED] instructed [REDACTED] to record a second video showing [REDACTED] attempting to lift her arms independently. In the video, [REDACTED] cried in pain and demonstrated difficulty lifting her right arm. [REDACTED] sent both videos to Sgt. Chapman to keep with the incident photo file.

[REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] should be evaluated in person by a physician and, due to the time of day, stated that the emergency room was the appropriate option. [REDACTED] transported [REDACTED] to the Cleveland Clinic Fairview Emergency Room, arriving at approximately 1800 hours. [REDACTED] notified [REDACTED] of the reason for the emergency room visit and sent him the photograph and videos of [REDACTED] injury. [REDACTED] estimated that [REDACTED] arrived at the emergency room sometime between 1930 and 2000 hours. Approximately twenty minutes after [REDACTED] arrival, [REDACTED] was seen briefly by the triage doctor before being directed to continue waiting. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] became frustrated with the wait time and expressed a desire to leave the emergency room. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] she would leave only if [REDACTED] advised that it was acceptable to do so. [REDACTED] contacted [REDACTED], who stated that if they left the emergency room that evening, [REDACTED] would need to be evaluated by a doctor the following day.

[REDACTED] returned home from the emergency room with [REDACTED] on the evening of February 18, 2026. On the following day, [REDACTED] took [REDACTED] for an in-person evaluation with [REDACTED]. During the

appointment, ██████ recommended that ██████ receive an X-ray. After ██████ took a nap, ██████ transported ██████ to the UH Urgent Care in Westlake for imaging. A fracture was identified on the X-ray. ██████ then recommended that ██████ undergo a full medical workup at the Cleveland Clinic Main Campus. ██████ subsequently took ██████ to the Cleveland Clinic Main Campus, where physicians evaluated her and confirmed that ██████ had a broken collarbone. The recommended plan included a follow-up X-ray in seven days and an appointment with an orthopedic surgeon. Due to the nature of ██████ injury, both the Cleveland Clinic and ██████ filed a report with Children and Family Services. ██████ reported that she contacted CFS ██████ to inquire whether the case had been assigned to her, and ██████ stated that it ultimately was. ██████ stated she was familiar with ██████r due to a previous case ██████ worked with ██████.

I asked ██████ when ██████ was evaluated by ██████. ██████ stated that social worker ██████ from Children and Family Services visited ██████ and ██████ on Friday, February 20, 2026. During this visit, ██████ photographed ██████ injury and took measurements of the bruise. ██████ stated that ██████ sent the photographs to ██████ for her assessment. ██████ further reported that ██████ did not examine ██████ in person. I asked ██████ whether ██████ had provided any information regarding ██████ assessment. ██████ stated that ██████ only advised her that there was concern about the bruise, specifically based on its positioning on ██████ body.

██████ confirmed that she left for ██████ to visit her mom on Saturday February 21st, at approximately 1800 hours. ██████ confirmed the first time she noticed ██████ injury was during bath time on Wednesday, February 18, 2026. I asked ██████ whether she had observed any signs of pain from ██████ when getting her in or out of a car seat. ██████ stated she had not taken ██████ anywhere in the days prior to noticing the injury and that ██████ would have been the one responsible for placing ██████ in and out of the car seat during that period. ██████ noted that she did pick up ██████ in the car from ██████ residence on Monday February 16th, but did not observe any injury at that time. When asked, ██████ stated she had not noticed any injury during clothing changes prior to Wednesday evening. I also asked ██████ whether she had any thoughts regarding how ██████ may have sustained the injury, whether it be accidentally or intentionally. ██████ stated she did not.

I asked ██████ how long ██████ had been employed as ██████ nanny. ██████ stated ██████ had been working for the family since March of 2026. ██████ described ██████ as outgoing and reported that ██████ has a long history of working with children and serving as a nanny. ██████ stated her best friend, ██████, lives in the same development as ██████ and employs a nanny named ██████. ██████ explained that ██████ and ██████ have become good friends. ██████ reported she has had no issues with ██████ during her employment. I asked ██████ whether ██████ had contact with anyone other than ██████, ██████, and ██████. ██████ stated she would need to confirm with ██████ whether ██████ had been taken anywhere else. ██████ explained that ██████ typically plans activities for ██████ on the days she watches her. ██████ reviewed the nanny's activity schedule and noted that the entry for Tuesday, February 17th, indicated "swimming at the rec center," but stated she would have to check with ██████ to determine whether ██████ actually went or not.

In order to determine who may have had access to ██████, I asked ██████ whether she had a significant other. ██████ stated she did not. I then asked whether she knew if ██████ had a significant other. ██████ stated that ██████ is dating a woman named ██████, and it is ██████ understanding that ██████ and ██████ live together. I asked ██████ whether she had ever met ██████. ██████ stated she had seen ██████ in person twice at ██████ residence but does not speak with her. I asked whether ██████ had access to ██████. ██████ stated ██████ car is present in ██████ driveway at every drop-off and pick-up, and based on that, it is her understanding that ██████ sees ██████. ██████ also stated the nanny, ██████, has seen ██████ several times. ██████ stated ██████ told her that ██████ works evenings. ██████ said she did not want to speak further about ██████ because she does not

know much about her. I advised [REDACTED] that my questions were solely to determine who had access to [REDACTED].

Sgt. Chapman asked [REDACTED] when she first considered the possibility of child abuse in relation to [REDACTED] injury. [REDACTED] stated that a doctor at the Cleveland Clinic Main Campus told her on Thursday, "I don't think you should give your child back to dad." Sgt. Chapman clarified that the doctor appeared to believe [REDACTED] injury was consistent with child abuse. I asked [REDACTED] what she thought of that comment. [REDACTED] stated, "It was hard to hear." She further stated that the situation felt confusing because the comment was made in isolation, and afterward, they were told they could go home. [REDACTED] reported that hospital staff at the Main Campus informed her they were contacting Children and Family Services due to the injury. When asked whether hospital staff mentioned contacting law enforcement, [REDACTED] stated that no one brought that up to her.

Sgt. Chapman asked [REDACTED] for her thoughts regarding the cause of [REDACTED] injury. [REDACTED] stated she did not know who caused the injury but acknowledged that [REDACTED] causing the injury was a possibility. When asked why she believed that, [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] sometimes becomes angry and that she has observed him become angry in the past. Sgt. Chapman asked [REDACTED] whether she had ever seen [REDACTED] physically harm [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she had not. [REDACTED] also stated that [REDACTED] has said, "Daddy angry," and "Daddy's house is scary." According to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] articulated these statements to Children and Family Services.

[REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] has been having difficulty sleeping due to her injury and has been waking at approximately 0200 hours each night experiencing night terrors.

Sgt. Chapman asked [REDACTED] when she believed [REDACTED] injury may have occurred. [REDACTED] stated, "After Saturday," referring to February 14, 2026. [REDACTED] explained that [REDACTED] did not seem the same after [REDACTED] dropped her off at [REDACTED] residence on February 14, 2026, at approximately 1300 hours, compared to how [REDACTED] appeared when [REDACTED] spoke with her via FaceTime on Sunday, February 15, 2026.

At this point in the interview, [REDACTED] went to check on [REDACTED], who was being watched in the home by her maternal grandmother and was crying. While [REDACTED] was out of the room, Sgt. Chapman asked Attorney Donovan DeLuca if there was anything we were forgetting to ask [REDACTED]. Donovan stated there was something he had instructed [REDACTED] to tell the police, but he was not going to force [REDACTED] to share her story. Upon her return, [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] had stepped on a toy during bath time, which caused her to cry. When asked, [REDACTED] also confirmed that [REDACTED] does not attend daycare.

I advised [REDACTED] that Children and Family Services had provided information indicating she had disclosed past abuse involving herself and [REDACTED]. I asked [REDACTED] if she wished to share that information with law enforcement. [REDACTED] stated she did not. Attorney DeLuca told [REDACTED] that if she had anything she wanted to say, now would be an appropriate time, but she was not required to say anything. [REDACTED] stated, "I already said, I think sometimes [REDACTED] gets angry." I asked [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] had ever hurt her. [REDACTED] nodded her head yes. I asked whether she wanted to talk about it. [REDACTED] stated she did not know where to start. [REDACTED] stated she had been scared of [REDACTED] a lot, and that was why she moved out of their home. [REDACTED] stated she moved out when [REDACTED] was in a different part of the state.

I asked [REDACTED] if she wanted to discuss any specific incidents. [REDACTED] began crying and covered her face with her hands. [REDACTED] stated, "I think he just gets really mad at me sometimes." I asked [REDACTED] how [REDACTED] would get mad at her. [REDACTED] stated that while they were married, [REDACTED] would become angry when the baby was crying and he wanted [REDACTED] to make the baby stop crying. [REDACTED] stated this behavior began shortly after [REDACTED] was born. [REDACTED] stated there were a few occasions when she

would need to change the baby's diaper, and "he would have his gun on me." I asked [REDACTED] to describe this further, and she began crying again. [REDACTED] stated it was embarrassing. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was upset because she wanted to leave. [REDACTED] stated the first time she wanted to leave was in January of 2024. I asked [REDACTED] what she remembered about that time. [REDACTED] stated she remembered being scared and being in the bedroom of their previous home in [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] confirmed that [REDACTED] was approximately two to three months old at the time of the incident she described. [REDACTED] stated it was New Year's Eve, and [REDACTED] became angry with her over something she "did wrong," though [REDACTED] stated she could not recall what the argument was about. [REDACTED] stated she remembered that they went to bed arguing. [REDACTED] stated that the next day, she called her father to pick her up and intended to tell him what had happened and that she wanted to leave. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] had already called her father beforehand and told him she was "causing issues," presenting a different story. [REDACTED] stated she went to get coffee with her father, and during that conversation she told him that "sometimes [REDACTED] hurts her feelings." [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] frequently told her that her parents hated her. [REDACTED] reported that her father told her it sounded like [REDACTED] was emotionally abusive toward her. [REDACTED] stated her father then dropped her back off at the house, which she described as confusing to her.

I asked [REDACTED] when the incident involving the firearm occurred. [REDACTED] stated it was on December 31st (referring to 2024). [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] was upset, the baby was crying, and [REDACTED] told her she was "doing everything wrong." [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] wanted quiet because "he works so hard." [REDACTED] stated it was late at night and the baby was sleeping in a bassinet in the bedroom she shared with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] side of the bed had [REDACTED] bassinet, and the baby's changing station was located on [REDACTED] side of the bed. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] wanted the room quiet so he could watch a movie. [REDACTED] stated she took [REDACTED] to the changing table and turned on a light in the bedroom, which made [REDACTED] upset. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] yelled at her after she turned the light on, though she stated she did not recall what he said. I asked [REDACTED] when the firearm came into play. [REDACTED] stated it occurred while she was changing [REDACTED]. I asked [REDACTED] what [REDACTED] did with the gun. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] "held the gun" on her.

I asked [REDACTED] if she could show me where [REDACTED] held the gun. [REDACTED] began crying, covered her face with her hands, and stated she did not want to talk about it. [REDACTED] left the room briefly to get a tissue. Upon her return, [REDACTED] stated she told her therapist about the gun incident, but it wasn't reported to the police. I asked [REDACTED] if she wanted help reporting this incident to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated no and indicated that no one would believe her.

[REDACTED] reported that during her relationship with [REDACTED], she increasingly felt isolated. She stated she slowly felt that she was on an island and was not permitted to visit her friends. When asked, [REDACTED] stated the relationship shifted to physical abuse prior to their marriage in August of 2022. I asked [REDACTED] whether she had ever seen [REDACTED] hurt [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] did not spend time with [REDACTED] when they were married. She stated he never engaged in activities with [REDACTED] on his own and that when [REDACTED] was home from work, he did not want to spend time together as a family of three. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] told her that [REDACTED] did not need two parents watching or spending time with her. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] would choose to go inside his bedroom rather than spend time with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she never saw [REDACTED] verbally or physically abuse [REDACTED].

I advised [REDACTED] Children and Family Services had made the police department aware of a recent domestic incident involving [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. I asked [REDACTED] if she wished to discuss the matter. [REDACTED] stated that on Sunday, February 1st, her friend [REDACTED], who lives in her neighborhood, was hosting a joint birthday party for her sons from 1500 to 1700 hours. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] was scheduled to be with [REDACTED] until 1800 hours; however, [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] if she could pick up [REDACTED]

earlier so [REDACTED] could attend the birthday party. [REDACTED] reported that she repeatedly asked [REDACTED] what time she would be able to pick [REDACTED] up and stated she "was probably being annoying" in trying to determine the time. According to [REDACTED], she and [REDACTED] eventually agreed that she would pick up [REDACTED] at 1600 hours.

[REDACTED] stated that when she arrived at [REDACTED] residence at the agreed-upon time, [REDACTED] was still in her pajamas and appeared upset. [REDACTED] asked if [REDACTED] could be dressed in other clothing since they were going to a birthday party. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] became upset because he believed [REDACTED] was criticizing what [REDACTED] was wearing. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] obtained an outfit for [REDACTED], and as [REDACTED] began to get [REDACTED] dressed, [REDACTED] became angry because he believed [REDACTED] was taking away from his parenting time. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] then pushed her into a wall, causing her to fall to the ground. [REDACTED] stated she was fine, left with [REDACTED] and went to the birthday party.

When asked, [REDACTED] stated the incident occurred in the entryway of [REDACTED] house. [REDACTED] subsequently drew a picture on notebook paper depicting her position in the entryway at the time of the alleged assault, marking her standing location with an "X." I asked [REDACTED] if she could demonstrate how [REDACTED] had touched her by using her attorney, Donovan DeLuca, as a model. [REDACTED] placed both of her hands on DeLuca's upper shoulder area to demonstrate. Attorney DeLuca asked [REDACTED] if she wished to show police the photograph she had previously shown him. [REDACTED] stated yes, but said she did not want the picture to leave her house. [REDACTED] said she did not want to share the picture because she did not want anyone to know about the incident. [REDACTED] added that since February 1st, [REDACTED] had begun being nicer to her and they had been getting along. [REDACTED] stated that she and [REDACTED] recently took [REDACTED] to a play center together, which was the first time they had done something together with [REDACTED]. I asked [REDACTED] if she wished for law enforcement to investigate the domestic incident between her and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she did not know. Attorney DeLuca suggested that [REDACTED] take time to think it over and decide later if she wanted to move forward. [REDACTED] stated it was just her word against [REDACTED].

Prior to the interview concluding, [REDACTED] brought 2 y/o [REDACTED] into the dining room. Photographs were taken of [REDACTED] collarbone, however, the bruising had healed. I did observe a pink circular skin irritation on the rear center of [REDACTED] neck, but it did not appear to be a bruise.

February 26, 2026:

At approximately 9:00 AM, an interview was conducted with [REDACTED] in the presence of his legal counsel. [REDACTED] arrived prepared with a printed timeline documenting his time with his daughter, [REDACTED], during the period in question. [REDACTED] explained that he first became aware of the bruise on [REDACTED] collarbone when [REDACTED] contacted him through Our Family Wizard (OFW) to inform him she was taking [REDACTED] to the emergency room. [REDACTED] emphasized that [REDACTED] had been in the care of [REDACTED] and their shared nanny, [REDACTED], immediately before the bruise was discovered.

[REDACTED] stated that recently he and [REDACTED] have been spending more time together, particularly during [REDACTED] classes. He also reported that on Sunday, February 22, 2026, [REDACTED] came to his home during his visitation time to see [REDACTED], who was sick with strep throat. [REDACTED] said he allowed the visit and has been cooperative and accommodating in co-parenting interactions. He offered full cooperation with the current investigation, including unrestricted access to his home for law enforcement and child protective services.

[REDACTED] described a recent pattern in which he and [REDACTED] attend [REDACTED] Saturday morning [REDACTED] classes together. He said this level of cooperation is unusual compared to their past interactions but has been consistent over the last couple of months. He also mentioned that he recently petitioned to modify the parenting agreement and was granted all of his requests, while [REDACTED] requests were denied. He did not provide further details about the modifications.

[REDACTED] further explained that he and [REDACTED] have recently been visiting each other's homes for short periods to discuss matters related to [REDACTED]. Approximately one month prior, [REDACTED] was invited to [REDACTED] home in [REDACTED] to discuss [REDACTED] sleep difficulties. During that visit, [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] to stay with [REDACTED] while she left to get a "wax." [REDACTED] stated he felt this situation illustrated the recent positive trajectory of their relationship. [REDACTED] described a recent change in [REDACTED] behavior that concerns him. He explained that [REDACTED] had previously been very comfortable with him around her and [REDACTED], often calling for him to "come inside" when he knocked at her front door. In contrast, her demeanor has shifted abruptly, which feels inconsistent with their previously positive interactions.

[REDACTED] expressed significant distress regarding the current allegation that he caused injury to [REDACTED], emphasizing that this is the second time he has been accused of harming her. He stated that his primary concern is not the accusation itself, but the fact that [REDACTED] has had to experience these incidents. [REDACTED] reported feeling frustrated and believes that [REDACTED] is fully aware of how [REDACTED] injury occurred. According to [REDACTED], he suspects that [REDACTED] is taking steps to make it appear as though he is responsible.

[REDACTED] cited several actions by [REDACTED] that he believes support his concern. He noted that [REDACTED] took [REDACTED] to both a doctor and a hospital without informing him beforehand. He also reported that [REDACTED] asked him to take custody of [REDACTED] on a day that falls outside of their established custody agreement. [REDACTED] found this request unusual, and he pointed out that it occurred around the same time [REDACTED] injury was discovered.

During the conversation, [REDACTED] briefly referenced the previous incident in which he was accused and investigated for injuries [REDACTED] sustained. He stated that the investigation concluded he was not responsible and that a settlement was issued to him from the individuals ultimately found to

be responsible for [REDACTED] injuries. [REDACTED] indicated that this history contributes to his frustration with the current situation.

During the interview, [REDACTED] encouraged investigators to speak with the family's shared nanny, [REDACTED], stating that he believed she could provide clarity and valuable information regarding the current concerns. [REDACTED] alleged that [REDACTED] has not allowed [REDACTED] to communicate with their court-appointed parent coordinator, [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED] attorney, Pamela MacAdams, parent coordinators are typically assigned in high-conflict divorces involving children, with the purpose of resolving disputes quickly and without the need for repeated legal intervention. MacAdams reported that [REDACTED] attempted to contact [REDACTED] for two days following the initial emergency room visit but was unsuccessful. She further stated that [REDACTED] was later advised by her legal counsel not to communicate with [REDACTED] or [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] expressed frustration that he learned about [REDACTED] subsequent medical visits through other individuals rather than directly from [REDACTED]. He described previous incidents in which [REDACTED] sustained minor injuries consistent with those commonly seen in two-year-olds. [REDACTED] emphasized that he never contacted authorities or accused [REDACTED] of wrongdoing in those past situations. However, given the current circumstances, he now questions whether [REDACTED] may have been responsible for [REDACTED] recent injury.

[REDACTED] also described recent behavioral concerns, noting that [REDACTED] has begun expressing frustration by intentionally banging her head on the floor. He stated that he attempts to redirect her toward more positive ways of expressing emotions. [REDACTED] acknowledged that he disciplines [REDACTED] and admitted he could "do a better job," but he believes [REDACTED] behavior around [REDACTED] is more damaging. He referenced prior concerns, including [REDACTED] being subjected to a SANE exam at one year old.

Regarding the current injury, [REDACTED] stated he does not know how [REDACTED] sustained the bruise near her collarbone and said he would have disclosed any information he had, even if the injury were accidental. [REDACTED] and his attorney offered their own beliefs about the cause of the injury. Using a printed photograph, they suggested the bruise resembled a seatbelt mark based on its location and shape. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] has a poor driving record and suggested the injury could have occurred while [REDACTED] was driving with [REDACTED]. He also noted that [REDACTED] sometimes drives [REDACTED] when [REDACTED] is not present, and that [REDACTED] is only driven by him when she is in his care.

[REDACTED] also commented on the color of the bruise. He referenced a bruise on his own arm from an IV placed seven days earlier, stating that he and [REDACTED] share a similar skin tone. He believed the coloration of [REDACTED] bruise suggested it was older than reported and therefore likely occurred while she was in [REDACTED] care.

The conversation then shifted to a detailed review of the custody timeline surrounding the alleged injury:

- Thursday, February 12, 2026 (6:00 PM): [REDACTED] was with [REDACTED] at his home. No one else was present.
- Friday, February 13, 2026: [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] cared for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was present from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM.
- Saturday, February 14, 2026: [REDACTED] attended [REDACTED] class from 9:30 AM to 10:15 AM. [REDACTED] transported her from the class and did not return her to [REDACTED] until 1:30 PM. [REDACTED] stated he does not

know where [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were during that time. The remainder of the day was spent at [REDACTED] home with no other individuals present.

- Sunday, February 15, 2026: [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] was acting “horrible” because she was sick. He took her temperature, which showed no fever. [REDACTED] called and asked to come over due to [REDACTED] condition. [REDACTED] initially stated [REDACTED] arrived around 11:00 AM and stayed for approximately one hour. He later corrected the time after playing a recording taken at 8:58 AM while he and [REDACTED] were in the basement discussing someone referred to as “the Rooster” and [REDACTED] girlfriend. [REDACTED] did not mention anyone else being at the home on this day.

- Monday, February 16, 2026: [REDACTED] picked [REDACTED] up from [REDACTED] home at 8:00 AM and transported her to [REDACTED] house. A doctor evaluated [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] home and diagnosed her with strep throat. [REDACTED] stated that no injuries were noted by the doctor at that time. He also reported that during the emergency room visit two days later, [REDACTED] showed no signs of pain or limited mobility. [REDACTED] described an incident in the ER where [REDACTED] jumped into the air and gave him two high-fives with her arms fully extended, which she did without discomfort and in the presence of medical staff. [REDACTED] agreed to let [REDACTED] stay with [REDACTED] that night due to her illness.

- Tuesday, February 17, 2026: [REDACTED] contacted [REDACTED] and asked if he wanted to take [REDACTED] for the night, even though it was not his scheduled day. [REDACTED] stated the offer felt unusual but that he accepts such opportunities because he wants to spend time with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] went on to explain how [REDACTED] becomes exhausted at times and will ask him for help. [REDACTED] feels this is due to [REDACTED] inability to care for someone without exhaustive help from others. [REDACTED] took custody of [REDACTED] at approximately 4:00 PM this day and she stayed with him until approximately 9:00 AM the following day.

- Wednesday, February 18, 2026: At approximately 1800 hours, [REDACTED] reported receiving a text message from [REDACTED] via the Our Family Wizard (OFW) application. [REDACTED] advised she observed a bruise on [REDACTED] prior to giving her a bath at [REDACTED] residence. [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] if he had any knowledge of the bruise or how [REDACTED] may have sustained the injury. [REDACTED] further stated she had spoken with “[REDACTED],” who suggested [REDACTED] be taken to the hospital for evaluation. The messages included photographs depicting [REDACTED] injury. At the time the messages were received, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] reported he left the event and met [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] at Fairview Hospital approximately 45 minutes later. [REDACTED] said he asked [REDACTED] to contact [REDACTED] primary care physician (PCP) to determine whether they should continue waiting. According to [REDACTED], the PCP advised that if both parents agreed [REDACTED] appeared healthy enough to leave, they could do so and she would see [REDACTED] at a later time. [REDACTED] expressed concern that waiting at the emergency room would result in them returning home around 1:00 AM. He stated that he and [REDACTED] mutually agreed to leave without [REDACTED] being evaluated.

[REDACTED] reported that he canceled a planned work trip to [REDACTED] due to [REDACTED] injury and his belief that [REDACTED] would be taking [REDACTED] to her PCP the following day. He later learned [REDACTED] took [REDACTED] to the doctor without notifying him and without giving him the opportunity to attend. [REDACTED] stated that their shared custody agreement requires [REDACTED] to disclose all medical appointments. He further expressed concern that [REDACTED] may have encouraged the doctor to consider the possibility of abuse by him during that visit. [REDACTED] reported he had not heard from [REDACTED] since the second doctor appointment. [REDACTED] stated that after waiting an extended period of time to be seen by medical personnel, he and [REDACTED] discussed the situation and decided to leave the hospital. [REDACTED] reported this occurred at approximately 0030 hours on February 19, 2026.

• Thursday, February 19, 2026: [REDACTED] stated he contacted [REDACTED] via OFW requesting updates on [REDACTED] condition. [REDACTED] also advised [REDACTED] he was canceling an upcoming trip to [REDACTED] so he could remain available should [REDACTED] require additional medical care. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] did not respond until later that afternoon, at which time she advised she had taken [REDACTED] for an x-ray. [REDACTED] stated he informed [REDACTED] that, per their shared custody agreement, she is required to notify him when [REDACTED] receives medical attention. [REDACTED] reported he received no additional information regarding [REDACTED] condition on that date.

• Friday, February 20, 2026: [REDACTED] reported receiving a text message from [REDACTED] advising that [REDACTED] had a broken collarbone. [REDACTED] stated this was the first time he became aware of the seriousness of the injury. [REDACTED] reported the message contained no additional details. [REDACTED] stated he contacted [REDACTED] by phone and requested further information. [REDACTED] provided a transcription of the phone call, which documented a discussion regarding the timeline of [REDACTED] seeking medical care for [REDACTED] on Thursday, February 19, 2026. During the call, [REDACTED] stated she took [REDACTED] to see "[REDACTED]" between approximately 1200 and 1300 hours. [REDACTED] stated she believed she had messaged [REDACTED] about the x-ray, though [REDACTED] stated he believed he had proof she did not. [REDACTED] further stated that after the appointment, she allowed [REDACTED] to nap before taking her to the Cleveland Clinic main campus for x-rays. [REDACTED] stated she had been overwhelmed with everything going on.

• Saturday, February 21, 2026: [REDACTED] reported participating in a FaceTime call with [REDACTED] lasting approximately five minutes. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was present with her mother during the call. [REDACTED] reported he did not observe [REDACTED] wearing a sling or notice anything that would indicate a severe injury.

• Sunday, February 22, 2026: [REDACTED] remained in [REDACTED] care. [REDACTED] reported there was no communication from [REDACTED] and no additional information provided regarding [REDACTED].

• Monday, February 23, 2026: [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] canceled the nanny's scheduled work. [REDACTED] stated there was no communication between himself and [REDACTED] on this date.

• Tuesday, February 24, 2026: [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] again canceled the nanny's work. [REDACTED] stated he did not receive any communication from [REDACTED] and became concerned for [REDACTED] well-being. [REDACTED] reported he contacted the [REDACTED] Police Department and requested a welfare check on [REDACTED].

• Wednesday, February 25, 2026: [REDACTED] reported receiving a FaceTime call from [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated they appeared to be inside an airport. [REDACTED] reported he was unaware of any scheduled travel involving [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and suspected they had traveled to [REDACTED], possibly to [REDACTED] parents' condominium. [REDACTED] stated he believed this travel violated their shared custody agreement. [REDACTED] reported he was upset due to having canceled his own [REDACTED] travel plans to remain available for [REDACTED], only to later observe [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] leaving the state. At the time of the interview, [REDACTED] stated he did not know with certainty where [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] traveled but suspected the location was [REDACTED] Airport based on his prior travel experience and observations during the FaceTime call. [REDACTED] played the recorded FaceTime call for clarification.

[REDACTED] stated he believed [REDACTED] had been advised by her legal counsel to refrain from communicating with him. [REDACTED] further stated that after [REDACTED] legal counsel was contacted by his legal team and advised that [REDACTED] would pursue court action to amend the custody agreement if [REDACTED] continued withholding [REDACTED], [REDACTED] decided to return.

[REDACTED] confirmed all referenced communications occurred through the Our Family Wizard

application. [REDACTED] stated he exclusively uses OFW to ensure communications are documented and reported that [REDACTED] has occasionally attempted to communicate outside the platform. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] has never sustained an injury while in his care and stated he has never accused [REDACTED] of intentionally harming [REDACTED], despite injuries occurring while [REDACTED] was in [REDACTED] care.

[REDACTED] provided information regarding a prior child abuse allegation involving [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated he was previously accused of causing an injury after observing a "knot" on [REDACTED] head following pickup from a daycare in [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated daycare staff advised [REDACTED] had fallen earlier in the day. [REDACTED] reported that an investigation conducted by Cuyahoga County Children and Family Services Investigator [REDACTED] determined [REDACTED] had been abused by daycare staff. [REDACTED] stated the findings resulted in legal action against the daycare and a settlement. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] did not participate in the lawsuit.

[REDACTED] further reported that during a meeting with [REDACTED] related to that matter, [REDACTED] stood up, pointed at him, accused him of abusing their daughter, and exited the room. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] disagreed with [REDACTED] statement. [REDACTED] stated he believes [REDACTED] behavior has also impacted the nanny, [REDACTED], whom he reported has been left uninformed and had her work canceled, affecting her pay. [REDACTED] stated he believes [REDACTED] is overwhelmed and requires assistance managing serious matters.

[REDACTED] and his legal team were asked specifically what they believed [REDACTED] intention would be if the allegations of child abuse were inherently untrue. [REDACTED] offered immediately that he does not feel [REDACTED] is "well", referring to her mental health. Attorney MacAdams suggested, while mental instability was a possibility, she was likely trying to harm his [REDACTED]. Furthermore, MacAdams suggested [REDACTED] is not getting the desired attention from [REDACTED] and he acts out in this manner.

[REDACTED] and his legal counsel advised they are willing to provide documentation from the Our Family Wizard platform or any additional records relevant to the investigation. Contact information was provided for [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].

The investigation into the matter is ongoing.

On 2/26/2025, Det. Sgt. Chapman and I met with [REDACTED] in the PD main interview room. Upon sitting with [REDACTED], she was advised we were investigating allegations of abuse involving [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] verified she was aware of the investigation.

[REDACTED] verified she is currently employed as [REDACTED] nanny, further verifying her employers are [REDACTED] parents, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED], she solicits her services through a nanny placement agency called [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] verified she has been working as [REDACTED] nanny since 3/10/2025 and her contract goes to 3/6/2026. According to [REDACTED], she has been a professional nanny for over twenty (20) years, adding she went to nanny school for formal training.

According to [REDACTED] since starting as [REDACTED] nanny on 3/10/2025, she has only seen bruises on [REDACTED] once. [REDACTED] explained that right when she was hired, [REDACTED] had bruises on her. [REDACTED] stated she was told when she started that [REDACTED] had been in day care and she suffered some injuries while in day care. [REDACTED] stated it was her understanding that it was proven that day care employees were responsible for the bruises on [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] added that [REDACTED] actually just settled a lawsuit with the day care. [REDACTED] verified she was never interviewed, nor was she a part of [REDACTED] injuries from the day care.

According to [REDACTED] a normal day working for [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] consists of working Monday through Friday from 9am to 3pm. [REDACTED] stated she usually goes to [REDACTED] house to start nannying [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she doesn't work at [REDACTED] house often. According to [REDACTED], upon arriving at work, she starts doing whatever [REDACTED] needs her to do. [REDACTED] stated she will get [REDACTED] dressed, start breakfast for [REDACTED] and then usually start playing with [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED], there are times she will take [REDACTED] out of the house for things like [REDACTED] class on Tuesday's or [REDACTED] on Thursday's. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] loves music, so they often times listen to music and talk. [REDACTED] stated that her and [REDACTED] will also do play dates with [REDACTED] friend's daughter and her nanny. [REDACTED] stated she will either make lunch for [REDACTED] or take her out for lunch. After lunch, [REDACTED] stated she usually plays with [REDACTED] or reads books with her and then [REDACTED] will go down for a nap. According to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] usually goes down for her nap around 1:30pm and at that time [REDACTED] starts to clean and organize [REDACTED] house until it is time for her to leave for the day. According to [REDACTED], she also takes time to work on her "lesson plan," adding she makes a lesson plan for [REDACTED] for the entire week. [REDACTED] stated that her lesson plan consists of what they are going to eat each day, what they are going to do each day, etc.

[REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] always know what she is doing with [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] usually works from home, so she is usually on-site and up in a bedroom working. [REDACTED] stated that her and [REDACTED] Face Time [REDACTED] on a daily basis as well.

When asked about her routine when she is at [REDACTED] house, [REDACTED] stated it's usually the same routine at [REDACTED] house, with the exception of [REDACTED] usually being the one that makes [REDACTED] her breakfast, adding [REDACTED] likes to make [REDACTED] eggs for breakfast. [REDACTED] stated she doesn't see [REDACTED] as much because he is usually traveling for his job. [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. When asked if she uses her own car to drive [REDACTED] around or if one is provided, [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] bought her a car so she could have a reliable vehicle to get [REDACTED] where she needs to go. [REDACTED] stated that it is common for families that hire nannies to provide a car for the nanny.

█████ verified █████ and █████ have shared custody of █████. █████ stated the custody agreement is planned out for the entire year, but added it can change on the fly. █████ stated she just goes where she is told to go, whether the schedule is changed or not. According to █████, the family has dogs and the dogs go wherever █████ goes, whether it be at █████ or █████ house. █████ stated the only visitor █████ has at her house is her mother, but added that █████ mother recently moved to █████, so she isn't around very often anymore. When asked about █████ house, █████ stated he usually has his mother over and he has his girlfriend, █████, come over occasionally. █████ stated she doesn't see █████ often.

When asked how much interaction █████ has with people other than her (█████) or █████ and █████, █████ stated whenever █████ is with her, she never lets █████ out of her custody, unless she is going to the bathroom.

When asked about █████ car seat that she uses, █████ stated it is a rear facing car seat that █████ provided. █████ stated the car seat is a high end one, that actually has airbags on it.

█████ gave the following time line for the week of 2/16/2026 through 2/20/2026:

Monday 2/16/2026: █████ explained that she got to █████ house in the morning and █████ was laying on the floor and screaming/crying. █████ stated █████ was not acting like herself and she didn't want to be put down after █████ picked her up. █████ stated she held █████ and tried to play with her, but she didn't want to play or do anything but be held. █████ stated, later in the morning, around 11am, she told █████ she felt █████ needed to see a doctor because of how she was acting. █████ stated █████ stomach hurt and her breath smelled and she knows from experience those are symptoms of a throat infection. █████ stated █████ subsequently called the doctor (█████) and the doctor came to the house to see █████. According to █████, the doctor assessed █████, but was not able to remove █████ shirt because █████ was so fussy and screaming. █████ added that █████ requested that the doctor test █████ for drugs. █████ stated she felt that was an odd request. When asked if she believed █████ was implying that █████ somehow obtained or ingested some type of drug at █████ house, █████ stated yes, but added she did not actually hear █████ say that. When asked if she felt █████ was off base asking for a drug test, based on what she knows of █████, █████ stated yes. █████ stated the doctors determination was that █████ had strep throat and her behavior was attributed to the strep throat. █████ stated the doctor did not test █████ for drugs. █████ stated the doctor prescribed Amoxicillin for █████ and █████ picked it up at the pharmacy. According to █████, she went back to █████ house with the medication and gave it to █████. According to █████, shortly thereafter, she helped █████ put █████ down for a nap. █████ stated she did not recall if she took █████ shirt off when she changed her for her nap, but added she did not believe she did. █████ stated █████ never cried or showed difficulty moving her arms when she changed her for her nap. █████ stated she rocked █████ to sleep and then "put her in her bed." █████ then went home at 3pm.

Tuesday 2/17/2026: █████ stated she was scheduled to go to █████ house on this date, but the plan changed and she went to █████ house at 9am. █████ recalled Face Timing █████ According to █████, █████ was still somewhat sick, but feeling a little better from taking the antibiotic. █████ did not recall taking █████ out of the house because she was still fighting the strep throat. She recalled playing and reading books on this date. █████ stated she did not notice █████ favoring her arm or acting as though she was in pain. █████ stated she decided to give █████ a bath because she had Amoxicillin in her hair and she did not see any bruises on her. █████ commented that █████ told her she gave █████ a bath on Monday night. After █████ bath, █████ put █████ down for her nap. █████ stated she left at 3pm. █████ stated, later that night at 7:57pm, she got a text from

█████, asking her to pick █████ up from █████ house the next morning (Wednesday). █████ stated she had no details on when █████ would have gotten to █████ house or how. █████ believed █████ probably went to █████ to pick up █████ and bring her back to his house, but she could not be sure.

Wednesday 2/18/2026: █████ stated she showed up at █████ house a little before 9am. She recalled █████ girlfriend being at the house and the dogs acting crazy. █████ recalled saying hello to █████ girlfriend, adding she calls her █████. █████ stated █████ wanted to stay at █████ house. █████ put the dogs in █████ car and then they put █████ in her car seat in the car. █████ then took █████ to █████ house, adding █████ was home when they got there and she greeted them. █████ stated █████ had fed █████, so she didn't have to feed her. █████ stated she gave █████ her medication and then took her upstairs and got her changed. █████ stated she did not see any bruising on █████ when she dressed her. █████ stated █████ would have had on zip up pajamas, so she would have unzipped them to take them off and then she would have put a shirt on █████. █████ stated she saw no bruises, but added the bedroom would have been dark. █████ stated at 10:45 am, she took █████ to story time at the █████. At this point in the interview, █████ showed us a photo she took of █████ at the library, adding she took it to send to █████ and █████. █████ stated she felt █████ was "holding her arm." █████ showed us the photo, which is open to interpretation on whether it indicates █████ is in pain at that time. █████ stated █████ had a good time at the library and she did not appear to be in pain. When asked if █████ showed any signs of pain getting into or out of her car seat, █████ stated she did not notice anything unusual. █████ stated she never saw █████ holding her arm in pain. █████ stated they left the library at around 11:30am and they went back to █████ house. Once back at the house she makes lunch for █████ and it's a typical day. She did not give █████ a bath. At about 1:00pm, she took off █████ sweater and put her in a sleep sack and put █████ down for a nap. At 3pm █████ left to go home. █████ stated she initially learned about █████ shoulder injury when █████ texted her later in the day at 4:31pm. █████ pulled up the actual text to check the date and time and she read the following to us: "What happened to █████ neck...did you notice?" █████ texted back "Does it hurt if you push on it?" █████ then suggested to █████ via text that █████ possibly bumped her head under the table and that hurt her neck. █████ then texted █████ a picture of █████ with her bruise. █████ stated that █████ called her shortly thereafter. According to █████, she told █████ to take █████ to the doctor if she didn't know what happened to her. █████ stated she heard that █████ and █████ ended up taking █████ to the ER, but they ended up leaving. According to █████, she heard from █████ that they left because it was going to be a long wait before they could see a doctor.

Thursday 2/19/2026: █████ stated she worked 9am to 3pm on this date, but didn't remember anything unusual about this date. █████ stated █████ did not seem to be in any pain and she appeared to be better with the strep throat because of the Amoxicillin. According to █████, when she arrived at the house at 9am █████ and █████ were still sleeping, which is not typical. After they woke up, █████ told █████ that they were at the hospital the night before and █████ made them leave. █████ stated she asked what the doctor's said and █████ stated "It will work out as it should." According to █████, she decided to not ask anymore questions. █████ stated █████ called her on Thursday evening. According to █████, █████ advised her she was "losing it" and she needed her to come over and watch █████ because she was on the phone with doctors. █████ agreed and went over to █████ at 6pm. █████ stated when she arrived at 6pm at █████, she found out that after she left at 3pm, █████ took █████ to an Urgent Care and a doctor at the Urgent Care told █████ to take █████ to the hospital downtown. █████ stated she ultimately left █████ house at 7:45pm because █████ was leaving to take █████ downtown to the hospital. █████ stated she offered to go with █████ and █████ to the hospital, but █████ stated no because her mother was flying into town that night to be with them at the hospital. When asked if █████ ever mentioned to her that she thought █████ caused █████ injury, █████ stated no.

Friday 2/20/2026: [REDACTED] stated she went to [REDACTED] house at 9am and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were sleeping. [REDACTED] got up and told [REDACTED] they got home at 1am. [REDACTED] began making [REDACTED] waffles and sausage and then went upstairs to get [REDACTED] and she changed her. According to [REDACTED], when she went upstairs, she saw that [REDACTED] mother was there and they briefly talked. [REDACTED] stated she brought [REDACTED] downstairs to feed her. [REDACTED] stated she asked [REDACTED] and her mother if they wanted her to make them something to eat as well, but they stated they were leaving so [REDACTED] could take her mom home to drop her off. After [REDACTED] and her mother left and then [REDACTED] ate her breakfast. [REDACTED] added [REDACTED] ate very well. [REDACTED] stated, after [REDACTED] ate, she wanted to play so they pulled out the puzzles and books. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] took out her shape/face toys to talk about her emotions, adding [REDACTED] is "really smart" and she will talk about whether she is feeling sad or happy. [REDACTED] further explained that [REDACTED] has play items that have faces on them (happy face, worried face, angry face, etc.). According to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] always says the red/angry one is daddy. [REDACTED] laughed and stated she doesn't understand why [REDACTED] says that because she ([REDACTED]) has never seen [REDACTED] angry, as he is always "happy go lucky." According to [REDACTED], after she and [REDACTED] played, she decided to take [REDACTED] to Target so they could look for a new toy. According to [REDACTED], she put [REDACTED] in her car seat to prepare to take her to Target and [REDACTED] did not show any pain. [REDACTED] stated, while they were at Target, [REDACTED] called her to tell her that child protective services was going to come to the house. [REDACTED] stated she then took [REDACTED] home. [REDACTED] stated, once at home, [REDACTED] ate lunch. After lunch, [REDACTED] stated she needed to change [REDACTED] because she got some of her lunch on her clothing. While changing [REDACTED], [REDACTED] came into the room and stated she had important news and then shouted "we're going to [REDACTED]." After this, [REDACTED] stated she put [REDACTED] down for her nap. After putting [REDACTED] down, [REDACTED] mother came over and she chatted with her for awhile. [REDACTED] stated she was aware [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] flew to [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] mother on Saturday (2/21) and came back on Wednesday (2/25). [REDACTED] stated the news about leaving for [REDACTED] came out of the blue.

According to [REDACTED] she spoke with child protective services on 2/25/2026. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] has asked her how her interview was with child protective services. According to [REDACTED], she told [REDACTED] she was doing what is "best for [REDACTED]." [REDACTED] stated she couldn't imagine either [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] hurting [REDACTED] intentionally. [REDACTED] stated it makes more sense that [REDACTED] injury was accidental. [REDACTED] stated she believes [REDACTED] injury was an accident because [REDACTED] throws herself to the ground and throws herself everywhere. When asked how she interprets [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] relationship, [REDACTED] stated it's a "love/hate relationship," adding they love to hate each other. [REDACTED] stated she does feel [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have a respect for each other, but behind the scenes they tear each other apart. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] always talk about suing each other quite a bit. [REDACTED] feels [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] should have no contact with each other, as it would be in their best interest. [REDACTED] stated, despite their poor relationship, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] relationship has recently been pretty good. [REDACTED] stated she is aware that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have recently been going to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] classes together and [REDACTED] has gone to [REDACTED] house a few times. According to [REDACTED], she has only seen [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] together on one (1) occasion, adding it was about one (1) month ago when [REDACTED] came over to [REDACTED] house to get the dogs.

When asked to describe [REDACTED] as a person, [REDACTED] described her as a factual person and "all business." [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] is getting her work done and taking calls when she ([REDACTED]) is around. She described [REDACTED] as a "no frills person." [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] loves [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] described [REDACTED] in the same way, as loving with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she has never seen anything concerning at [REDACTED] house or [REDACTED] house. [REDACTED] stated the only thing she doesn't like is that [REDACTED] "throws herself down on the floor" or throws something to get attention. [REDACTED] added [REDACTED] will "hit herself or hurt herself" for attention. When asked to expound upon her statement that [REDACTED] throws herself to the ground/hits and hurts herself, [REDACTED] described an incident when they were sitting on the floor playing with a puzzle the other day and [REDACTED] got upset, so she threw her head

back and onto the ground. [REDACTED] stated she told child protective services about [REDACTED] tendencies to throw herself to the ground and she asked child protective services if [REDACTED] could have accidentally hurt herself. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] will throw herself flat on the floor and hit her head on the floor to the point where she ([REDACTED]) checks her to make sure she's not hurt. [REDACTED] stated she has not seen anything in the past couple weeks where [REDACTED] could have accidentally injured her own shoulder. [REDACTED] stated she can't believe [REDACTED] has a broken collar bone because it doesn't appear to affect [REDACTED]

When asked if she has any indication to believe [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] have any type of mental issues, [REDACTED] stated no. She added she feels [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] both have stressful jobs and both react in different ways. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED]. She stated [REDACTED] job allows him to have more time with [REDACTED] when he's home. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] does a good job dividing his time with [REDACTED], but [REDACTED] works all day and can only have her time with [REDACTED] later in the day. [REDACTED] stated her services are needed more for [REDACTED], as opposed to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] added [REDACTED] has more family around to help him, as opposed to [REDACTED] not having family around.

[REDACTED] verified that, prior to being told about [REDACTED] shoulder injury on 2/18/2026, she never seen any injuries to [REDACTED] and never felt she was injured in any way. [REDACTED] also reiterated she doesn't suspect [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] of hurting [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she aspires to be a long term nanny for [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], adding [REDACTED] family still has the same nanny that [REDACTED] grew up with and she aspires to be like that. [REDACTED] stated "it's an honor" to nanny [REDACTED]

Based on the previous day's conversation with [REDACTED], the [REDACTED] Library System was contacted for information related to obtaining video from the [REDACTED] Branch. After contacting a representative at the [REDACTED] Branch, I was directed to Richard Gerena. Gerena was contacted and advised this agency would be obtaining a Grand Jury Subpoena requesting video retained by the [REDACTED] Library System for the [REDACTED] Branch, located at [REDACTED] [REDACTED] on February 18, 2026, between the hours of 10:00 AM EST and 12:00 PM EST. Gerena requested basic information about the individuals being looked for on camera and indicated he would search the available videos to determine if the requested video existed.

A Grand Jury Subpoena was requested from Katie Demyan at the Cuyahoga County Prosecutor's Office. The subpoena requested the aforementioned information. The subpoena was issued shortly thereafter. As the subpoena was being generated by Demyan, Gerena called reporting he located the two individuals described at the library. Gerena provided still images of the individuals he identified. These individuals were confirmed to be [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Gerena was advised of the same and asked to gather the video footage that captured [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] movements. The images provided by Gerena was kept for evidence. Gerena was also provided a copy of the subpoena.

Contact was made with [REDACTED] attorney, Donovan DeLuca (216-480-3001). The purpose of contacting DeLuca was to discuss and determine [REDACTED] intention of filing a police report related to her allegations of domestic violence. [REDACTED] disclosed a number of past domestic violence incidents that were never reported to police. The most recent of which was alleged to have occurred on February 1, 2026 in Bay Village, Ohio. The incident was discussed in some detail on February 25, 2026 at [REDACTED] home. However, at the conclusion of that conversation, [REDACTED] and LeLuca indicated they needed to speak privately about the matter before [REDACTED] decided whether or not she wanted to file a report. DeLuca advised he did not have an answer from [REDACTED] about her intention to file a police report. Deluca was assured, [REDACTED] could file a report with our agency at any time, if she wished to file a police report about the incidents. He indicated he would reach out to me when and if a decision is made.

Later this same day, Gerena called stating he was able to obtain the requested video from the library. Gerena advised he would come to the police station on Monday March 2, 2026 and provide me with the video.

The investigation into this matter is ongoing.

On February 28, 2026, I was contacted by [REDACTED] via text message. She began by asking whether anyone had submitted a public records request related to this ongoing incident. I informed her that, as of late Friday February 27, 2026 no such request had been made.

[REDACTED] then shifted the conversation to a different matter, asking whether I was aware [REDACTED] had filed a protection order against her. I told her I had no prior knowledge of any order. [REDACTED] proceeded to send me a copy. The document listed only [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] as the involved parties. The protection order appeared to have been granted on February 26, 2026, with a duration of one year.

During the conversation, [REDACTED] expressed concern that the order would prevent her from seeing [REDACTED]. However, [REDACTED] was not named anywhere in the order, and no restrictions regarding visitation with [REDACTED] were indicated. [REDACTED] was advised I would look into the matter when I returned to work on Monday March 2, 2026, but the order appeared to be related to the civil aspects of her relationship with [REDACTED] and their custody agreement.

Later this same day, Gerena arrived on station with the surveillance video from the [REDACTED] Branch location. The video was provided as a result of providing the [REDACTED] Library a subpoena for the footage. As previously discussed, Gerena was able to locate [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] at the [REDACTED] Branch library on February 18, 2026. Gerena provided me with screenshots from the video footage and I was able to confirm their identities in the pictures.

The video was reviewed in its entirety. The following events from February 18, 2026 were noted:

- 10:29:57 AM: The video begins, showing the Main Doors, Circular Desk, Parking Lot Center, and Storytime Room camera angles.
- 10:30:30 AM: [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] come into view on the parking lot camera as they walk toward the main doors of the library. [REDACTED] is holding [REDACTED] left hand.
- 10:30:45 AM: They walk through the main doors into the vestibule. [REDACTED] is wearing black pants, pink/red shoes, a blue vest, and a black long-sleeved shirt. [REDACTED] is wearing pink pants and a red shirt or jacket.
- 10:30:52 AM: [REDACTED] runs a short distance away from [REDACTED] and climbs onto a large orange circular bench in the vestibule under her own power. [REDACTED] watches.
- 10:31:04 AM: [REDACTED] moves across the bench from front to back and climbs down on the opposite side. [REDACTED] sits on the bench.
- 10:31:26 AM: [REDACTED] climbs onto the bench again, traverses it, and gets down. [REDACTED] takes her left hand and they walk through the inner doors into the library.
- 10:31:35 AM: Still holding hands, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] walk out of the Main Doors camera view and

further into the library.

- 10:36:56 AM: [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] reappear on the Circular Desk camera. Their location had been unknown since they left the main doors. They walk the length of the desk, with [REDACTED] walking beside [REDACTED] but not holding her hand.
- 10:37:18 AM: They arrive at a set of tables visible on the Storytime Room camera.
- 10:37:28 AM: [REDACTED] attempts to climb onto a plastic chair at the first table. She places her left hand on the chair and tries to pull herself up with her right hand but does not get onto the chair. She then attempts the chair next to it, placing her right hand on the chair and pulling with her left. The video does not show why she switched chairs. [REDACTED] sits in a chair at the second table, close to [REDACTED] but not at the same table.
- 10:37:45 AM: [REDACTED] uses both hands and arms on the tabletop to support herself as she gets seated on the chair she selected.
- 10:38:07 AM: [REDACTED] stands, places a sticker name tag on [REDACTED] shirt, and then sits directly next to her at the same table.
- 10:38:33 AM: [REDACTED] colors at the table, using both hands and arms without any visible difficulty.
- 10:39:40 AM: [REDACTED] gets off her chair, pulls another chair out from under the table using her left arm, and appears to attempt climbing onto it while holding a crayon in her right hand.
- 10:39:52 AM: [REDACTED] changes direction and climbs back onto her original chair, using both hands to ascend.
- 10:40:28 AM: [REDACTED] lifts [REDACTED] from the chair by placing her hands under [REDACTED] armpits and sets her on the ground next to the chair. She then takes out her phone and positions [REDACTED] near a bookcase, apparently to take a photograph.
- 10:41:04 AM: After the photo, [REDACTED] climbs back onto the chair, placing her left hand on the chair back and her right hand on the table as she pulls herself up. She resumes coloring, using both hands to manipulate objects.
- 10:43:44 AM: [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] get up from the table and begin preparing for the story time event. This consisted of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] standing in an area next to the tables with other individuals waiting to enter the story time room. [REDACTED] is observed walking back and forth in the area waiting to be allowed inside the room. [REDACTED] waits with [REDACTED] close behind.
- 10:45:05 AM: [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] walk toward the storytime room. Once inside the story time room, [REDACTED] sits in a chair on the perimeter of the room and out of sight from the camera. [REDACTED] can be seen walking and running around the room with the other children.
- 10:47:14 AM: The doors to the story time room are closed the individual presenting the story time, a white female wearing all black, standing in the middle of the room in front of the kids. At this point, [REDACTED] is the only child standing in the middle of the room with the story teller. The other children are with their caretakers seated in the chairs surrounding the story teller. The story teller shows [REDACTED] her musical instrument, which looks to be a small guitar.

- 10:47:39 AM: Other children from the perimeter of the room come to the story teller and look at the instrument. [REDACTED] remains with them.
- 10:48:17 AM: The story teller appears to begin playing the guitar. The other children return to the perimeter of the room with their caretakers and [REDACTED] remains in front of the story teller dancing.
- 10:48:24 AM: [REDACTED] runs to the perimeter of the room and off camera. Likely running to [REDACTED] who is seated in this area. At this point, there are approximately 11 adults inside the room, including the story teller. There are approximately the same number of children in the room. In total, there appears to be 20-22 people inside the room.
- 10:49:09 AM: [REDACTED] is observed coming into camera view after running to the center of the room and in front of the story teller.
- 10:49:47 AM: The story teller prompts all of the participants to raise their arms as part of the production. [REDACTED] is positioned in the middle of the room, but a clear view of her is obstructed by one of the adults seated in front of her. [REDACTED] can be seen raising her left arm into the air. It does not appear she is raising her right arm, however, the view is obstructed by the seated adult.
- 10:50:01 AM: The story teller prompts the room to raise their arms again. This time, [REDACTED] can be seen raising both her left and right arms into the air. After putting her arms down, [REDACTED] remains in the center of the room dancing to the song.
- 10:50:26 AM: [REDACTED] runs from the middle of the room and back to where [REDACTED] is seated out of the camera's view. For a brief moment, [REDACTED] can be seen being picked up by [REDACTED] through the window. [REDACTED] is seen holding [REDACTED] above her shoulder height for a brief moment before appearing to place her on her lap.
- 10:51:02 AM: [REDACTED] returns to the middle of the room and stands in front of the television placed in the middle of the room.
- 10:51:39 AM: An adult male and young boy walk hand-in-hand into the story time room. They open the door and join the group. [REDACTED] remains in the center of the room.
- 10:52:08 AM: The story teller prompts the class to place both of their hands on top of their heads. [REDACTED] does not appear to participate in this action, but places her hands along the left and right sides of her face. It should be noted, [REDACTED] is again partially obscured from view by one of the adults seated in a chair behind her. There is a brief moment where it appears [REDACTED] left arm is on top of her head, but her right side cannot be seen clearly.
- 10:53:08 AM: The story teller prompts the group again to touch the top of their head with both arms. [REDACTED] does not participate. [REDACTED] remains in the center of the room and dances. The story teller prompts the group to bend over and touch their knees. [REDACTED] participates as instructed. The story teller prompts the group to squat down and touch their toes. [REDACTED] participates as instructed. [REDACTED] remains in the center of the room in front of the story teller and dances.
- 10:54:52 AM: The story teller prompts the group to cover their ears with both their right and left hands. [REDACTED] does not participate, but turns around and watches the others in the group perform the action.
- 10:55:15 AM: [REDACTED] sits down on the carpet in the center of the room. Shortly after, the story teller

prompts the group to slap both of their knees with both of their hands. [REDACTED] does not participate and remains seated on the carpet.

- 10:57:05 AM: An adult woman carrying a young girl in her arms opens the door to the story telling room and joins the group.

- 10:57:36 AM: [REDACTED] is observed still seated on the ground. At times, she is observed placing her hand onto the carpet and leaning toward her right looking in [REDACTED] direction. As she sits on the ground, she is observed leaning to her right, with her right hand planted on the carpeting.

- 10:58:05 AM: The story teller presents the group with a plate or platter of items. She starts in the middle of the room and appears to offer these items to members of the group. [REDACTED] eventually stands up from the carpeting and goes toward the story teller. By this time, the group has converged around the story teller obstructing a clear view of [REDACTED].

- 10:58:18 AM: [REDACTED] can be seen walking up to the television at the front of the room and reaching for the screen with her left arm and hand. Shortly after, the story teller knees down next to [REDACTED] and allows her to take some items from the tray. She then returns to [REDACTED] out of camera view.

- 11:00:42 AM: [REDACTED] and another child are standing at the front of the room with the story teller.

- 11:01:15 AM: The story teller appears to start gathering the items she previous passed out to the children in the group. [REDACTED] is seen throwing her item into the ground. She almost immediately bends down and picks up the item. She lowers the tray and appears to ask the children to return the items.

- 11:01:23 AM: [REDACTED] is observed walking to the right side of the room behind some of the chairs that can be viewed on the camera. Behind one of the chairs which is occupied by an adult woman, [REDACTED] is observed bending down to the floor. The camera view is obscured as to what [REDACTED] is doing, but [REDACTED] is observed standing up at about the same time. [REDACTED] then walks to the front of the room, places an item on the tray, and returns to her seat. [REDACTED] remains unseen by the camera.

- 11:02:11 AM: [REDACTED] is seen reappearing on camera from behind the chairs. She runs to the middle of the room and hands an object to the story teller with her right hand. [REDACTED] immediately returns to [REDACTED].

- 11:02:36 AM: [REDACTED] walks to the middle of the room and takes a book from the story teller. She returns to [REDACTED] on the chair.

- 11:03:38 AM: The story teller gets a book and sits in the middle of the room. The children in the room are all with the adults in their chairs. The story teller begins to move around the room and show pages of the book to the group.

- 11:05:03 AM: [REDACTED] can be seen standing up in front of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] runs to the middle of the room and around the story teller. After running to in front of the story teller, [REDACTED] hands the story teller her book.

- 11:05:29 AM: Instead of returning to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] runs to the opposite side of the room and sits in a chair next to the wall.

- 11:05:37 AM: [REDACTED] is observed running across the middle of the room toward [REDACTED]. Once she

arrives to [REDACTED], she immediately turns around, runs back to the middle of the room, runs in a circle, and runs back to [REDACTED].

- 11:06:06 AM: [REDACTED] is observed running from [REDACTED] and back toward the middle of the room. [REDACTED] stops briefly in the middle of the room, but then runs to the opposite side of the room, past the circle of chairs, and off camera to the left of the camera's view.

- 11:06:25 AM: [REDACTED] reappears on the left side of the room and walks in the area behind the circle of chairs.

- 11:06:40 AM: [REDACTED] is seen running toward the right side of the room (opposite direction), however, she is behind the circle of chairs. She makes her way to [REDACTED] from behind where [REDACTED] is seated. [REDACTED] remains with [REDACTED], seated in a chair next to her, as members of the group begin to open a large multi-colored parachute in the middle of the room.

- 11:06:56 AM: Members of the group begin waving the parachute up and down as numerous children walk underneath the parachute while it's in the air. [REDACTED] can be observed seated in the chair next to [REDACTED] until 11:07:13 AM when she appears to get up. [REDACTED] movements are obscured at this point.

- 11:09:19 AM: [REDACTED] reappears from behind [REDACTED] location and can be seen partially in front of [REDACTED].

- 11:09:25 AM: [REDACTED] makes her way toward the parachute, which is still being waved. [REDACTED] does not go under the parachute, but instead stands at the edge looking underneath.

- 11:10:25 AM: [REDACTED] disappears out of view and appears to go underneath the parachute. The parachute continues to be waved up and down and [REDACTED] movements are concealed from view.

- 11:11:10 AM: The story teller collects the parachute from the other members of the group and balls it up into her arms. The last child to be revealed from underneath the parachute is [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] remains in the middle of the room momentarily before going to where [REDACTED] is seated. [REDACTED] remains there for a short period and then returns to the middle of the room with the other children.

- 11:11:47 AM: [REDACTED] is observed running toward the left side of the camera view behind the circle of chairs, appearing to follow the story teller, who is picking up a large bin of inflatable beach balls.

- 11:11:55 AM: [REDACTED] returns to the center of the room with the story teller. The story teller dumps the bin of beach balls into the center of the room and the children all grab one.

- 11:13:16 AM: The story teller begins blowing bubbles into the air above the children. [REDACTED] can be seen extending her left arm into the air grabbing for bubbles.

- 11:15:31 AM: [REDACTED] can be observed laying on the ground behind the story teller. She then sits up and appears to be playing with the beach balls on the ground. After a short while, [REDACTED] stands up and walked to the middle of the room in front of the story teller. She can be seen again holding up her left arm attempting to catch the bubbles.

- 11:16:40 AM: [REDACTED] is observed running to the left side of the camera view on the left side of the room and out of view.

- 11:17:38 AM: [REDACTED] stands up and looks in the direction of [REDACTED] last location. [REDACTED] still remains out of the camera's view. [REDACTED] traverses the room to her left and walks out of camera view in the direction of [REDACTED] last location.
- 11:18:00 AM: [REDACTED] appears back in camera view walking toward the center of the room. [REDACTED] does the same, however, walks behind the circle of chairs opposite [REDACTED].
- 11:18:37 AM: [REDACTED] walks through the center of the room and makes her way to [REDACTED] seated back in her chair.
- 11:18:56 AM: Story time appears to end. Adults begin standing up and members of the group appear to start picking things up around the room. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] can be seen walking toward the glass doors of the story time room.
- 11:19:29 AM: [REDACTED] is seen extending her right arm toward [REDACTED] encouraging her to take her hand as they begin to leave. [REDACTED] comes to [REDACTED] and takes her hand with her left hand.
- 11:19:37 AM: [REDACTED] looks behind her as she exits the door and waves back into the room with her right hand and arm.
- 11:19:48 AM: [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] walk hand-in-hand out of the story time room. They briefly walk down a book aisle (the same one the picture of [REDACTED] was taken earlier), but they turn around and head the opposite direction. In doing so, [REDACTED] raises her right arm and runs her hand along the back of the book shelf.
- 11:19:59 AM: [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are observed on the "Circular Desk" camera walking toward the main door of the library.
- 11:20:15 AM: [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] leave the "Circular Desk" camera view. Their movements and actions at this point are unknown.
- 11:27:28 AM: [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] appear again on the "Main Door" camera walking toward the main doors. [REDACTED] is holding [REDACTED] left hand with her right hand.
- 11:27:42 AM: [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] exit the library and are observed outside on the "Parking Lot Center" camera.
- 11:27:55 AM: [REDACTED] is observed being over and picking up [REDACTED] by placing both her left and right hands underneath both of [REDACTED] armpits. After picking her up, she places [REDACTED] on her right side and holds her using her right arm.
- 11:28:02 AM: [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] leave the camera view which is obscured by a large pillar in the front of the library. [REDACTED] vehicle lights can be seen illuminating as if she is unlocking her vehicle. The back passenger side door of her vehicle can be seen opening, however, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] movements are obscured.
- 11:29:20 AM: [REDACTED] opens her front passenger side door briefly and appears to put something into the passenger seat. She then walks around to the front driver side door and gets into the vehicle. The vehicle starts and they remain in the parking spot for a period of time.
- 11:30:18 AM: The video ends.

Based on the video review, it cannot be determined whether [REDACTED] sustained any injury at or prior to her arrival at the library. [REDACTED] use of her right arm varied throughout the footage: at times she did not use it, while at other moments she used it freely with no visible signs of immobility. There were periods where she appeared to favor her right arm and rely primarily on her left, but both arms were observed being used during the recording. No clear indications of pain were noted, and no obvious incident resulting in injury were observed. At this time, the presence or cause of any injury remains undetermined.

At approximately 12:22 PM, I received a message from [REDACTED] asking, "Can I make a statement about 2/1?" I understood this to reference the domestic violence allegation she previously disclosed during our earlier interview. [REDACTED] was informed that she could provide a statement and was advised to contact her attorney and come to the station.

[REDACTED] responded that she had spoken with her attorney and requested that I call her instead. I contacted [REDACTED] by phone, at which time she explained, although she wished to come in and make a statement, her legal counsel had advised her that filing a domestic violence report at this time could be perceived as retaliatory, given that a protection order had been awarded to [REDACTED] on Friday February 27, 2026.

[REDACTED] was assured that we were prepared to take her report if she chose to file one, but that it was reasonable to consider the guidance of her attorney if she was receiving conflicting advice. During the conversation, [REDACTED] expressed concerns regarding how the report would be documented, whether her account would be believed, and how the court case might be affected due to the time elapsed between the alleged incident and the reporting date.

These concerns were addressed, and [REDACTED] was provided with general expectations regarding investigative procedures, potential case progression, and her role moving forward should she decide to file a report. After discussing these matters, [REDACTED] ultimately stated she did not wish to file a report at this time and would continue to consult with her attorney regarding the issue.

At approximately 1535 HRS., [REDACTED] arrived at the Bay Village Police Department for a scheduled interview with Det. Sgt. Chapman and I. [REDACTED] was escorted into the conference room, where I introduced myself and advised her the purpose of the interview was regarding an injury sustained to 2-year-old [REDACTED]. I asked [REDACTED] to state her name and explain how she knew [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] confirmed her name and stated she has been dating [REDACTED] father, [REDACTED], since December of 2024. [REDACTED] indicated she met [REDACTED] approximately one month after beginning her relationship with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] further stated she sees [REDACTED] frequently when [REDACTED] is spending time with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she felt she had built a good relationship with [REDACTED] and advised she loved [REDACTED] as if she were her own child.

I asked [REDACTED] about her current living arrangements. [REDACTED] stated approximately half of her personal belongings are located at [REDACTED] residence. [REDACTED] explained she works the night shift and rotates between staying overnight at her workplace, [REDACTED] residence, or her parents' residence. [REDACTED] stated she was going through a dissolution prior to meeting [REDACTED] and, during that process, moved into her parents' home. [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] frequently travels to [REDACTED], and she does not stay at [REDACTED] residence when he is not present. [REDACTED] stated when [REDACTED] is home, she typically stays at his residence with him. [REDACTED] estimated she spends approximately three nights per week at [REDACTED] residence. [REDACTED] stated she began staying overnight at [REDACTED] residence in February of 2025, after [REDACTED] moved into his new residence in [REDACTED].

I asked [REDACTED] if she was aware of the injury to [REDACTED] that was being referenced in this investigation. [REDACTED] stated she was aware [REDACTED] had sustained a broken collarbone, but advised she only learned of the injury through information provided to her by [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she never personally observed the injury and did not notice anything that would have indicated [REDACTED] was injured. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was fussy during the weekend of Valentine's Day; however, [REDACTED] was later diagnosed with strep throat during that time. [REDACTED] stated she never observed [REDACTED] fall or trip, even accidentally, and did not observe [REDACTED] display any signs that something was wrong with her collarbone, such as favoring one arm or only raising one arm.

[REDACTED] stated that one to two nights prior to the injury being reported, she was not present for [REDACTED] bath time at [REDACTED] residence due to being at work. [REDACTED] stated she believed any injury or issue would have likely been observed by [REDACTED] during [REDACTED] bath time if something had been wrong. [REDACTED] advised she was not made aware of anything unusual and stated nothing was out of the ordinary during that time frame.

I asked [REDACTED] to describe her interactions with [REDACTED] during the Valentine's Day weekend while [REDACTED] was staying at [REDACTED] residence. [REDACTED] stated she worked the overnight shift Friday, February 13th into Saturday, February 14th. [REDACTED] stated she arrived at [REDACTED] residence between approximately 1600–1700 HRS. on Saturday, February 14th. [REDACTED] stated she and [REDACTED] had plans to go out to dinner and arranged for a babysitter to come to the residence. [REDACTED] advised that upon her arrival, she observed [REDACTED] to be very fussy, crying, and not wanting to separate from [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was laying on [REDACTED] chest and appeared clingy. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] primarily wanted to lay on the couch and watch Cocomelon. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] told her [REDACTED] had not been eating very well earlier that day. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] also advised [REDACTED] had taken a later nap and did not fall asleep until approximately 1530 HRS., and [REDACTED] had to wake [REDACTED] up around 1700 HRS. [REDACTED] attributed [REDACTED] fussiness to being awakened from her nap. [REDACTED] stated she had never seen [REDACTED] so fussy.

I asked [REDACTED] who the babysitter was that came to [REDACTED] residence to watch [REDACTED] while [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had planned to go out to dinner on Valentine's Day. [REDACTED] stated the babysitter was [REDACTED], whom she described as the same babysitter [REDACTED] had as a child. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] only uses [REDACTED] when they have an event to attend on a weekend. [REDACTED] estimated [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED] residence at approximately 1700 HRS., advising [REDACTED] was already present when [REDACTED] arrived. [REDACTED] stated their dinner reservations were scheduled for 1800 HRS.; however, the reservations were cancelled due to [REDACTED] behavior that evening. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] left the residence at approximately 1830 HRS. and advised [REDACTED] never watched [REDACTED] alone that evening. [REDACTED] stated she and [REDACTED] ordered food and ate dinner at the residence. [REDACTED] stated she had a popsicle with [REDACTED] and advised [REDACTED] ate some of the rice from [REDACTED] dinner. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] did not want to take a bath that evening, and bath time was skipped due to [REDACTED] not feeling well.

[REDACTED] stated that on Saturday (February 14th, 2026) night into Sunday (February 15th, 2026), she stayed the night at [REDACTED] residence. [REDACTED] advised that she returned to her parents' residence during the daytime hours on Sunday. [REDACTED] further stated that on Monday morning, [REDACTED] took [REDACTED] to a pediatrician appointment, during which [REDACTED] was diagnosed with strep throat. [REDACTED] indicated that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] discussed [REDACTED] condition and agreed it would be best for [REDACTED] to remain in [REDACTED] care overnight on Presidents Day (Monday, February 16th, 2026). [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] was returned to [REDACTED] care on Tuesday, February 17th, 2026.

I asked [REDACTED] to provide additional information regarding the weekend of February 14th, 2026. [REDACTED] stated that she stayed overnight at [REDACTED] residence Saturday February 14th, 2026 into Sunday, February 15th, 2026. When asked how [REDACTED] slept during that time, [REDACTED] stated there were no issues overnight and that [REDACTED] appeared normal the following morning. [REDACTED] advised that Sunday morning, [REDACTED] returned to bed for several hours, as she was scheduled to work an overnight shift later that evening. [REDACTED] stated she left [REDACTED] residence at approximately 1200 hours to go to her parents' home in [REDACTED] to prepare meals. [REDACTED] reported she returned to [REDACTED] residence for a short time prior to starting work at approximately 1900 hours. [REDACTED] stated she spent limited time with [REDACTED] on Sunday February 15th, 2026. [REDACTED] reported that during her interactions with [REDACTED], she did not observe [REDACTED] favoring one side of her body over the other and did not notice anything that would indicate an injury to [REDACTED] collarbone.

I asked [REDACTED] if she and [REDACTED] shared responsibility in caring for [REDACTED], including diaper changes, changing clothes, and bathing. [REDACTED] stated that they did share those responsibilities. I asked [REDACTED] if she noticed any injuries to [REDACTED] during those times. [REDACTED] stated she did not. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] did not take a bath on Saturday night (February 14th, 2026). [REDACTED] stated she was unsure whether [REDACTED] gave [REDACTED] a bath on Sunday (February 15th, 2026). [REDACTED] advised that if [REDACTED] had bathed [REDACTED], he did not report noticing any injuries. [REDACTED] further stated that [REDACTED] frequently takes photographs of any injuries he observes to [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] confirmed that [REDACTED] returned to [REDACTED] residence for President's Day on the morning of February 16th, 2026. [REDACTED] recalled that [REDACTED] returned to [REDACTED] residence on Tuesday, February 17th, 2026. [REDACTED] stated she did not arrive at [REDACTED] residence until approximately 1930–2000 hours on February 17th, 2026, at which time [REDACTED] was already asleep. [REDACTED] stated that on the following morning, the nanny arrived (later determined to be approximately 0900 hours) to pick [REDACTED] up. [REDACTED] reported that prior to the nanny's arrival, [REDACTED] appeared to be behaving normally, with the exception of not wanting to get dressed. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] spent time coloring in the living room and watching Cocomelon on television. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] did not eat much breakfast; however, she was not crying or fussy as she had been earlier during her strep throat diagnosis. [REDACTED] stated she provided the nanny with a Valentine's Day outfit she had purchased for [REDACTED].

█████ reiterated that she did not observe anything out of the ordinary during this time. █████ further stated that █████ spoke with the nanny, who also did not report noticing anything abnormal.

I asked █████ if she was surprised when she learned of █████ injury. █████ stated she was very surprised. I asked █████ what her initial thoughts were regarding how the injury could have occurred. █████ stated she found it strange that █████ messaged █████ on Wednesday February 18 th, 2026, prior to █████ first visit to the emergency room. █████ stated █████ asked █████ if he wanted to take █████ to spend additional time with her on a day that was not part of his originally scheduled parenting time. █████ advised that █████ was unable to do so due to a work event. █████ stated she found it odd that the injury was first noticed and reported by █████ later that same evening. Although, █████ added that in the past, if █████ needed to run errands, █████ has taken █████ on days that were not part of his assigned parenting time.

█████ stated after █████ noticed the injury, █████ met █████ and █████ at the emergency room. █████ reported that █████ believed █████ may have broken her arm. █████ stated █████ told █████ that while at the emergency room, he had █████ raise her arms, which █████ was able to do. █████ stated that █████ and █████ subsequently left the emergency room that same evening after █████ demonstrated she could lift her arms. █████ reported that on the following day, █████ took █████ to obtain an X-ray, at which time it was determined that █████ had sustained a fractured collarbone.

█████ stated █████, █████ has immediately accused █████ regarding any incidents involving █████. █████ stated that in this instance, █████ did not appear to be accusing █████, which █████ described as being inconsistent with █████ usual behavior. █████ stated that due to this, she believed the injury may have occurred while █████ was in █████ care. I asked █████ who she suspected may have caused █████ injury. █████ stated her initial reaction was that █████ may have fallen. █████ described █████ as very active and stated that although she did not personally witness █████ fall, █████ is an active toddler. █████ stated she did not believe █████ or the nanny would have intentionally harmed █████; However, █████ stated her assumption was that █████ may have accidentally sustained the injury while in █████ care.

I asked █████ if she had ever observed █████ act violently. █████ stated she had not. I asked █████ if █████ had ever been violent toward her or toward █████. █████ stated no and emphasized that █████ had never been violent. █████ recalled an instance in the past where she made a light-hearted joke to █████, stating something to the effect of, "you can slap me if I do something stupid." █████ stated █████ responded by telling her that it was not funny to joke about violence. █████ described █████ as being formal and nervous during exchanges with █████, stating that █████ is scared of █████ because █████ has called Children Family Services before. █████ stated that █████ has █████ wrapped around her finger and expressed that she believed █████ would never do anything to harm █████.

Detective Sergeant Chapman asked █████ if she had any interactions with █████. █████ referenced one occasion when she encountered █████ after picking █████ up following a doctor's appointment for █████. █████ stated █████ introduced her to █████ at that time. █████ reported that █████ looked her "up and down", but did not say anything. █████ stated that when █████ comes to █████ residence for custody exchanges, █████ typically "hides" inside the house because █████ does not seem pleasant. Detective Sergeant Chapman asked █████ whether, when █████ comes to █████ residence, it would be readily apparent that █████ was present. █████ stated yes, explaining that she normally parks either on the street or in █████ driveway. However, █████ physically tries to stay out of █████ view.

When asked where █████ was inside █████ residence on Sunday, February 15th, 2026, at the

time [REDACTED] came to [REDACTED] residence, [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] did not come over that morning. [REDACTED] stated she left [REDACTED] residence at approximately noon that day and [REDACTED] was not present at the residence prior to her departure.

I asked [REDACTED] if there was anything additional she wished to add. [REDACTED] stated she believed that what likely occurred was that [REDACTED], being a child, may have tripped and injured herself. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] chose to consider the situation as a worst-case scenario and contacted Children Protective Services. Detective Sergeant Chapman asked [REDACTED], whether she believed [REDACTED]'s injury could have gone unnoticed for a period of time or if she thought signs of the injury would have been apparent. [REDACTED] stated that it would depend on the severity of the fracture. [REDACTED] stated that, in hindsight, this may explain why [REDACTED] did not want to change her clothes. However, [REDACTED] stated that when the fracture initially occurred, she would have expected some outward display of pain from [REDACTED].

On 03.16.2026, I reviewed messages between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] on the platform 'Our Family Wizard', provided by [REDACTED] legal counsel. I identified electronic messages relevant to the time period surrounding [REDACTED] reported injury. A complete copy of Our Family Wizard messages are maintained within the case file. The messages below are a summary specifically pertaining to the timeframe in which the injury is believed to have occurred:

Monday February 16th, 2026:

Communication occurs throughout the day between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] regarding [REDACTED] diagnosis of strep throat. During this exchange, [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] of the physician's instructions, which included washing [REDACTED] toys and changing her toothbrush. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] agreed that [REDACTED] would spend the night at [REDACTED] residence. [REDACTED] further advised [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] had taken a three-hour nap and was doing better.

At approximately 1730 hours, [REDACTED] informed [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] was "doing great" and stated that [REDACTED] was "doing a mini dance party with her animals." [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] that he could pick [REDACTED] up Tuesday morning (02.17.2026) and keep her until 1800 hours, as he missed the previously scheduled Monday overnight visitation due to [REDACTED] illness.

At 1929 hours, [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] was experiencing a mild anxiety attack, which [REDACTED] described as similar to an incident that occurred on Sunday (02/15/2026).

At 1933 HRS., [REDACTED] further stated she had administered Tylenol to [REDACTED] approximately 15 minutes prior to sending the message.

At 1952 hours, [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] stated, "Daddy kill you," which [REDACTED] indicated was similar to a statement [REDACTED] made on Sunday (02.15.2026). When asked about the statement, [REDACTED] advised there was no way [REDACTED] was saying that, but agreed that he had heard [REDACTED] say it on Sunday.

Tuesday February 17th, 2026:

At approximately 0910 hours, [REDACTED] sent a message to [REDACTED] inquiring about [REDACTED] condition. [REDACTED] responded that [REDACTED] was doing well but had awakened once during the night and requested to be held. [REDACTED] offered to allow [REDACTED] to pick [REDACTED] up and have [REDACTED] stay overnight at [REDACTED] residence, Tuesday (02/16/2026) into Wednesday (02/17/2026), prior to his departure for [REDACTED].

Communication continues throughout the day. [REDACTED] agreed and advised he would pick [REDACTED] up at approximately 1630 hours on Tuesday (02/16/2026). It was further agreed that the nanny, [REDACTED], would pick [REDACTED] up from [REDACTED] residence at approximately 0900 hours on Wednesday (02/17/2026), prior to [REDACTED] scheduled flight. [REDACTED] informed [REDACTED] he was mistaken and his flight for [REDACTED] was not until Thursday (02/18/2026).

At 1616 hours, [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] via message that [REDACTED] "was in a frisky mood."

Wednesday February 18th, 2026:

At 0600 hours, [REDACTED] sent a message to [REDACTED] inquiring how [REDACTED] tolerated her medication and how she slept overnight.

At 0707 hours, [REDACTED] responded that [REDACTED] had some difficulty taking the medication, but was able to ingest it. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] received a full dose of Motrin, went to sleep at approximately 2033 hours, and was still sleeping at the time of his message.

At 0827 hours, [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] had eaten a very full breakfast.

At 1355 hours, [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] that she had a significant amount of work she could complete that evening if [REDACTED] wished to watch [REDACTED] again that night prior to his departure for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] further stated she wished to spend time playing with [REDACTED] after her nap and advised [REDACTED] to inform her regarding the possibility of an overnight stay, provided the evening continued to go well as previously described. * [REDACTED] does not open or read this message until 1639 HRS.*

At 1635 hours, [REDACTED] sent a message to [REDACTED] stating, "I'm all set actually thanks!!"

At 1800 hours, [REDACTED] sent a message to [REDACTED] stating, "Hi [REDACTED], I took a bath with [REDACTED] a bit ago and noticed a really large bruise. She is having problems raising her arm all the way up. [REDACTED] suggested I get an x ray. I'm on my way to get that done for [REDACTED] now. Did you notice anything happen this weekend or yesterday?"

At 1802 hours, [REDACTED] stated "No, not at all. Where are you going for an x ray? Do you have a picture of this? She was fine this morning with no issues at all."

At 1802 hours, [REDACTED] stated "Fairview."

At 1804 hours, [REDACTED] stated "That looks awful, she did not have any pain last night or this morning. Can you give me more details? I'm at work meeting but will leave".

At 1805 hours, [REDACTED] stated "I agree. As soon as I noticed it, I called the doctor and I'm now following her direction and taking her in. I don't have any details. I will be at Fairview".

At 1806 hours, [REDACTED] stated "Please let me know".

Communication continued into the evening regarding difficulty accessing [REDACTED] Cleveland Clinic MyChart account. At approximately 1831 hours, [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] that they were able to get [REDACTED] "in" and that the issue was related to Cleveland Clinic's system. [REDACTED] acknowledged that she may have been rude to [REDACTED] during their communication regarding the Cleveland Clinic MyChart issue, but stated her behavior was due to concern for [REDACTED].

Thursday February 19th, 2026:

At 0710 hours, [REDACTED] sent a message to [REDACTED] requesting that [REDACTED] keep him informed regarding [REDACTED] condition that morning. [REDACTED] advised that he had cancelled his trip to [REDACTED] and would remain home until Monday if [REDACTED] required any assistance.

At 0825 hours, [REDACTED] replied, "Ok."

At 1304 hours, [REDACTED] sent a message to [REDACTED] stating, "She needs an x-ray." *Our Family Wizard indicated that [REDACTED] did not open this message until Friday February 20th, 2026, at 1739 hours.*

Friday February 20th, 2026:

At 1739 hours, [REDACTED] sent a message to [REDACTED] requesting an update on [REDACTED] condition. [REDACTED] further asked [REDACTED] to advise him when [REDACTED] would be taking [REDACTED] for an x-ray.

At 1746 hours, [REDACTED] responded to [REDACTED] by stating, "She has a fractured collar bone".

At 1808 hours, [REDACTED] sent a message to [REDACTED] expressing dissatisfaction that he was not informed sooner regarding [REDACTED] fractured collarbone. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] should have notified him of every medical appointment [REDACTED] attended. [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] if she knew how [REDACTED] injury occurred and questioned whether the injury may have happened while [REDACTED] was in the care of the nanny, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] further stated that the bruise observed on [REDACTED] appeared to be several days old and advised he intended to have a physician review the photograph of the injury. [REDACTED] indicated that [REDACTED] became aware of the injury that morning and stated that [REDACTED] is not [REDACTED] father. [REDACTED] further advised that during a prior incident in which [REDACTED] sustained a black eye, he received minimal information regarding the circumstances. [REDACTED] also stated he would be sending a message to [REDACTED] regarding the matter.

At 1813 hours, [REDACTED] replied that she had informed [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] was taken to Fairview Hospital and that [REDACTED] was scheduled to see [REDACTED] the following day. [REDACTED] further stated that she had advised [REDACTED] she was taking [REDACTED] to obtain an x-ray. [REDACTED] indicated that the nanny, [REDACTED], inquired about the x-ray when she was present in person, at which time [REDACTED] advised her of the situation. [REDACTED] stated she did not know how [REDACTED] sustained the injury and indicated this lack of explanation was the reason she sought medical evaluation at Fairview Hospital. [REDACTED] further advised she was unfamiliar with [REDACTED] reference to a prior incident involving a black eye. [REDACTED] questioned who [REDACTED] intended to send photographs of [REDACTED] to, stating that [REDACTED] physician had already evaluated the injury and reviewed photographs.

On 03.18.2026, at 0930 HRS., a Zoom meeting was conducted involving Children and Family Services caseworker [REDACTED], Cleveland Clinic physician [REDACTED], Det. Sgt. Chapman, and myself. During the meeting, [REDACTED] presented a timeline of known facts and information regarding [REDACTED] injury. [REDACTED] reviewed the known facts of the case, photographs and surveillance video from the [REDACTED] Library depicting [REDACTED] in the presence of her nanny, [REDACTED].

After a thorough review, [REDACTED] stated she could not definitively determine a specific timeframe during which the injury occurred. However, after reviewing the library footage, [REDACTED] opined that [REDACTED] appeared to be favoring her right arm. [REDACTED] advised that clavicle fractures are common injuries in toddlers; however, she stated the bruising observed surrounding the clavicle fracture made the injury suspicious. [REDACTED] further advised the injury would have required a high degree of impact to occur. When asked, [REDACTED] advised she did not believe the injury was consistent with a motor vehicle-related incident, aggressive driving, or the use of a child restraint seat, and stated those mechanisms would not account for the specific pattern of bruising observed.
